## OUR JOURNEY TO 2017 NATIONAL AGILITY CHAMPIONSHIPS

### THE QUEST

Our quest started on December 1, 2015, the start of the point and QQ accumulation to qualify. Divot and I had just moved into Master classes, and truthfully, we were not a very consistent team. We were struggling with off courses, contact issues, and the ever-lasting “NO STAY” at the start line. I dutifully set up my tracking spreadsheet and probably entered more trials than I should have at the beginning of the year; but knowing that I would be taking the summer off, I was bound and determined to qualify before my summer break. Note to self – it is very unwise to put that kind of pressure on yourself. About 3 months into the qualifying period, we were only at a single QQ, contacts were better but still “NO STAY” at the start line – which caused me to be behind which resulted in off courses. I truthfully don’t remember which one of my dear agility friends told me this – but the bottom line was that her advice was to just skip worrying about the stay and just boom him and run. That was our turning point. Gone was the tension and the off courses, and the Q’s starting to come much more consistently. Divot was right – stays at the start line are overrated.

June 19, 2016 – we did it! All qualified for Nationals!

### THE EVENT

This was not my first time competing at NAC, so I knew a little of what to expect. But still, the sheer magnitude of the fairgrounds, arenas, number of dogs, noise and commotion is just overwhelming. Divot is a high drive but sensitive dog. I have to admit I was concerned about the effect the environment would have on him and our somewhat newly founded consistency.

### DAY 1 – PRACTICE ROUND

Oh yeah – just about everything I worried about happened and more. Divot was higher than a kite, shot out of my release at a newly found speed. Dropped bars, missed every contact – in fact – I had to repeat the teeter 3 times! Not exactly the start I was hoping for.

### DAY 1 – PREMIER COURSE

Much better result. Wrong end of the tunnel, my fault, but the rest was beautiful. Whew.

### DAY 2 & 3

Just one little thing on each course. A rare dropped bar, an off-course and another wrong end of the tunnel.



### REFLECTIONS

Truthfully, I have to admit that I was disappointed in our performance. It wasn’t like I expected to win the event, but I felt that we had been successful enough to put up a good show. Let me clarify, that I was not disappointed in Divot. He is the most amazing performance dog I could ever imagine. He loves the game beyond belief, he has unrelenting drive and a joy that is unmatched.

There are so many memories I will cherish about the 2017 NAC. The sheer joy of being a part of such an enormous event. (Kudos to AKC for orchestrating such a well-organized trial of this size) Watching some absolutely amazing agility teams giving it all out on the course. Watching the challenge rounds, hearing the crowds cheer – all for the love of the game. Then, of course, watching the finals – seeing teams coming together and embracing the moment.

### MY TAKE-AWAYS ARE

- The courses were not any more difficult than what we see in Minnesota during the year
- I felt like Divot and I deserved to be there
- It was awesome to meet some other bearded owners!

To close – I feel blessed to have such an amazing athletic partner who will play relentlessly. I think that anyone who competes in agility should experience NAC at least once in their lifetime. AND – lo and behold – we have already qualified for next year!

## IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BCCA BREEDER LISTING PROGRAM!

The procedure to list and renew breeder listings on the BCCA website has been greatly improved. The Board passed a motion approving the newly revised Breeder Listing Guidelines at the April meeting. Some of the highlights to these changes are that the yearly fee has been reduced from \$50.00 to \$25.00 and the renewal period has been shifted to coincide with the BCCA fiscal year, which goes from July to June. This means that you will be able to renew your BCCA membership and sign up for, or renew, your Breeder listing on the same form.

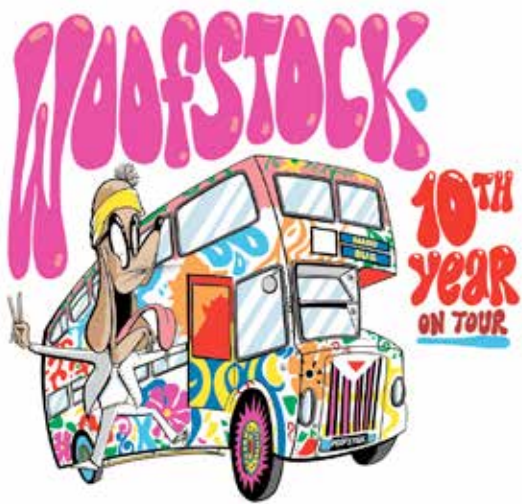

**Carol Steiner • A. M. Sweepstakes**

Carol has completed her approval for judging Rough and Smooth Collies, Shelties and she has become interested in judging other herding breeds including Bearded Collies. She has bred Collies for close to 35 years and Shelties for 10 years. Carol is a Breeder/Owner/Handler for her Collies and Shelties and is also active in Collie and Sheltie Rescue. Carol has given grooming seminars and trained conformation and puppy obedience classes. Two years ago, she retired from a 28-year sole ownership of Honeyblossom Farm Dog Training, where she taught obedience and conformation. Currently, she is the conformation instructor at Stone City Kennel Club in new Lenox, Illinois. She has been mentored in Bearded Collies and is currently waiting AKC approval.

**Robert H. Slay • A.M. Regular Classes**

Bob resides in Cary, North Carolina. He is a graduate of the University of Southern Mississippi and the US Naval Officers School. Bob was elected Vice-President of the AKC and served until retirement in 2004. He was state chairman of the Morris Animal Foundation and was a member of the original Steering Committee for the Dog Museum of America. Purebred dogs have been a major part of Bob's life for over 40 years. The Slays bred, owned, and showed German Shepherds. Bob served as President and Show Chairman for several all-breed and Specialty Clubs. He is currently President of the Cary Kennel Club. Bob has judged throughout the US and overseas. He is currently approved to judge all Sporting, Working, and Herding breeds plus 8 Terrier breeds.

**Cynthia Mahigian Moorhead, Parchment Farms Bearded Collies • P.M. Regular Classes**

Cynthia has had Bearded Collies since 1972 and intentionally maintained a small, but idealistic breeding program while concentrating from the very first on being a judge. She has produced champions from each litter that she has bred or co-bred, and has finished championships on every dog she has ever shown. Cynthia has been a licensed AKC judge for Beardies since 1984, when she became the first person licensed to judge the breed solely based on knowledge of the breed (having never owned another breed prior) and she has judged virtually all over the US and in Canada at all levels of competition from match to point shows. (Cynthia has never charged to judge Bearded Collies, a promise made to herself with her first assignment); as she states, "it's a privilege to be able to do what I love best in the ring"). In 1984 Cynthia judged the Sweepstakes at the BCCA National. One year later did the same for the Canadian BCC. In 1988 she judged the BCCA's National Specialty, the first-American breeder-judge to do so; as well she judged the 1993 Specialty, making her the first American breeder-judge to repeat that honor. She has twice been honored to judge at North of England Bearded Collie Club's Open Show, one of a handful of American breeder-judges to judge the breed in England. Cynthia belongs to both the Senior Conformation Judges of America Association and the Dog Judges of America Association. She currently lives with two Bearded Collie boys, Ramsay and Oliver, down from 14 at one time.
