

THERAPY DOG CERTIFICATES are awarded to Bearded Collies doing therapy work, based on verified hours of service, as follows:

Level I – a minimum of 25 service hours

Level II – a minimum of 50 service hours

Level III – a minimum of 100 service hours

Dogs must be certified through a therapy organization that requires certification and carries liability insurance (e.g., Delta Society, Therapy Dogs International) and handlers must be members in good standing of the BCCA.
