THE MASTERS AGILITY CHAMPIONSHIP, WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB 2016

Most, if not all of you, are familiar with the Westminster Kennel Club (KC) conformation show held in New York City every February. For some, it is a premier event to compete at, whilst for most, it is one to enjoy on TV. Three years ago the Westminster KC began to host an agility competition in conjunction with the prestigious breed show. It is staged on the Saturday prior to the Monday and Tuesday breed show.

I was thrilled to attend the 2014 inaugural Westminster agility competition as a spectator and watched my friend, Lil' Clove breeder Trudy Wisner compete in this new "theatre of agility" with her beardies, Poppet and Billy. This year, Trudy persuaded Claire Cifarelli and me to join her at the event with the next generation, my own Caol Ila (pronounced Cull-eela), Claire's B-Buster and Trudy's Dottie.

The Westminster competition is a two part event – an AKC agility trial, followed by a championship round. The trial was different to a regular weekend trial in that it was limited to dogs holding both Masters Standard and Masters Jumpers With Weaves titles (including preferred). There were two rings at the trial and two judges, one from America and one from Europe, which produces a variety of course styles. The results of this trial are used to calculate eligibility for that evening's Westminster KC Championship Round which is televised live on FOX Sports.

There was nothing about having an agility trial in the heart of Manhattan that seemed "regular"! The event, attended by 330 dogs from 28 states, was held on one of the Hudson River piers (the same location as the daytime breed show) where the cruise ships dock. The doors opened at 6 a.m., there is limited parking

available on the rooftop opening at 5 a.m., which means that we all left home before the crack of dawn to get there at 5 a.m. for the privilege of paying \$40 to park on the rooftop. Remember, this is Manhattan! This winter was a wonderfully mild winter in New York EXCEPT for the Westminster weekend when temperatures plummeted to well below zero.



Check-in was extremely well organized with different tables set up alphabetically. We were all given "goody bags" and were then directed to our benches. Just like the conformation show, this is a benched event allowing members of the public to visit the dogs.

Doors opened to the public at 8 a.m. just as the competitor walk throughs began, and my how the spectators streamed in. Attendance was around 20,000 for the daytime events, and another 5,000 for the evening's final round. The rings were arranged so that one complete side of the two rings was restricted to exhibitors (who were identified with wristbands), allowing us to enter and exit

with our dogs fairly easily. There were some bleachers but the majority of the crowd was left to standing room only.

The ring surface was an artificial turf that felt like a green scouring sponge. Most dogs ran well on it, but just as there often is at regular trials, there were some dogs that slipped.

Caol Ila's first run of the day was JWW. As I walked to the start line, I suddenly realized that this really was NOT a regular agility trial, regardless of what I had been telling myself. The crowd was immense and they were standing right against the ring fencing and were at least ten rows deep. The JWW course was designed by the European judge, who came from Sweden. It started with a very difficult and tight "European style" sequence

which gobbled up many teams but then opened up into a fast and furious run of weave poles and a broad jump (which you never see in the U.S. except in novice!) The weaves are always a crowd pleaser and the Westminster crowd was no different – as each dog went through the weave poles the crowd erupted with much “woo hoo-ing”. The qualification rate in the 20” jump height (where most beardedies compete), was fairly low until the end of the class, where handlers had the benefit of watching the earlier teams go through their paces and could adjust their game plans accordingly.

Following our first run, I decided to brave the freezing temperatures outside and take Caol Ila for a walk on the 12 inch strip (literally) of Manhattan grass running alongside the highway that the pier is located on. Each time I left the building the security guard would ask, “Won’t she go in the pen?” Hmm, we are used to doing agility outside in a field, with a handful of people watching, so no, she would not be “going in the pen”!

The AKC Meet the Breeds event was held in conjunction with the Westminster agility competition this year and we were able to visit the area in between our runs. Fortunately, the breeds were organized alphabetically starting closest to the agility benching area so our Beardedie friends were close by. The booth decorated and manned by the Garden State Bearded Collie Clan was very popular and mobbed for most of the day.

I was a little worried about my girl Caol Ila dealing with all the people. She loves her own entourage of “peeps”

but does not really have any interest in strangers. Of course, everyone wanted to talk to the eye-catching beardedies. I had a pocket full of kibble and just gave it to anyone who wanted to “talk” to Caol Ila. She decided that on that day, strangers were not quite so bad after all.

Just getting to our ring for our second class (Standard) was an obstacle course in itself, never mind planning the extra 30 minutes to get to the bathroom with their long lines!

The Standard course was designed by the American judge and was a fairly typical course. Unique to this trial however, was the dog walk running right along the ring edge with the packed bleachers and excited crowd only 10 feet away. The next obstacle which was also ringside was the table and many dogs found the crowd highly interesting – just as well the table is now non-positional as many dogs were pandering to the crowd, to their great delight.

There were many fabulous agility teams competing and as you would expect the border collies and shelties dominated their jump heights in number of entries and therefore “Q’s”. The objective of the Westminster KC Championship Round, that is televised live on FOX Sports, is not simply to feature the top teams in each jump height but to show the live spectators and TV

viewers that a large variety of breeds can take part successfully in our sport. In each jump height, the top three qualifying dogs, regardless of breed are chosen for the Championship Round. Dogs representing different breeds are then chosen from the remainder of the qualifying dogs to fill out each jump height.

“You could have knocked me down with a feather”, when someone came running over and said that Caol Ila was in the final. Well, they did not actually say that as no one can pronounce her name but that is o.k. – a beardedie was in the final!

We now had a four hour wait until 8 p.m. when the live TV coverage on Fox Sports began. Luckily we had brought extra snacks including special red velvet cupcakes decorated with Westminster purple frosting made by Trudy’s ever supportive husband Bobby who also drove us into Manhattan and “schlepped the stuff”. The wait also gave me time to text and call people, arrange for someone to DVR the event and for Claire to explain to her partner Tom, that we would be a bit late

home and check he was okay looking after the next crop of Lil’ Clove agility “wannabes” for another 6 hours! I also got to speak to my husband, Neil who was working on the west coast. Always supportive, he thought it was quite an oxymoron that I was going to be appearing on a sports channel! He did however get to watch us live.

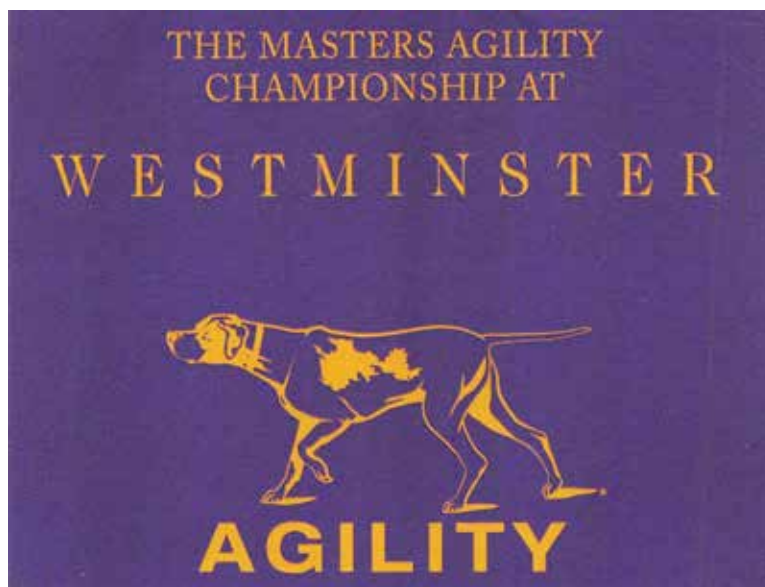
At 6 p.m. there was a briefing explaining how the live coverage would work and the rules of the class itself. The Championship course was a modified Time To Beat style course with a dog walk

added in. The scoring was unique in that no refusals were called and time faults were added for each wrong course or failure to perform an obstacle.

The spectators that had watched the day competition had to exit at its conclusion. Spectators for the evening portion (a separate entry fee required) began filing in at 7 p.m. and they too enjoyed meeting all the beardedies as we strolled around. If the daytime event had been a fine balance between what was right for the dogs and great for the spectators, then this was even more of a balancing act with the added addition of the needs of FOX TV. Space was very tight and there was no separation between exhibitors and spectators.

I walked my course and could see lots of agility friends in the front rows of the bleachers, right next to the dog walk (no pressure for that contact!).

The 20” jump height was the first group to run, represented by a Bearded Collie, Portuguese Water Dog, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, Hungarian Vizsla, Golden Retriever, All American as well as two Border Collies and two Australian Shepherds.



Caol Ila and I would be the second team to run and I had a couple of goals for our run. Not being the most slim-lined handler, my personal goal was for my trousers to stay up and my top to stay down – this was live TV after all. Secondly, Caol Ila is a wonderful dog who gives her all, but being ever the practical one; I knew that we were not going to beat the top three dogs for speed so my goal was our best clean run. When the previous dog was running, we had to clamber under the cameras to get into the ring and set our dogs up on a podium and “look interesting” and then we would be announced. I could sense Caol Ila starting to look at the cameras and people so we began doing some tricks on the podium – all caught on live TV. The announcer did a pretty good job of announcing her name. There was a ramp off the podium and looking back at the TV coverage, every dog automatically did a “two-on-two-off contact” coming off the podium.

Caol Ila was wonderful and I was so proud of the way she dealt with all the people and my anxiety. She had a beautiful clean run which included a start jumping right into the cameras, a tricky weave pole entry and exit, a “back side” jump (of course) and an interesting serpentine into the A Frame.

When we crawled out of the ring, under the cameras and lights, Trudy was waiting in floods of tears and I think that is when I realized that yes, we had really done this. Caol Ila had followed in the paw prints of her momma Poppet who ran in the final of the very first Westminster Agility Championships two years earlier.

Caol Ila and I finished in the middle of the pack less than 1/10th of a second out of third place. The 20” group was won by an Aussie who did indeed have a lovely clean run. FOX Sports must have enjoyed the beardie as whenever they needed a “fill-in” for their coverage, Caol Ila was doing the weave poles in slow motion with her coat flowing around them.

At the end of the night it was back to the roof top parking. The spectacular Manhattan skyline was all lit up, but we could not miss the biting wind blowing up off the Hudson River as we fought our way to the cars, beardie fur flying.

We ended the long, but incredible day in the best possible way... with great friends, New York pizza and reunited with the next generation of Lil’Clove agility “wannabies”.

As exciting as this event was, agility for me is really about the friendships we make along the way. Cheri Omnus, who asked me to contribute this article, may not remember, but Neil and I remember meeting her (hmmm) 17 years ago when she lived on the east coast and first started competing. At that time we had our very first beardie, Talisker (Briarpatch Double Scotch). The first beardie we ever met competing in agility was the legendary Breezy and Lu and Gerry Bergen. They were so friendly and encouraging, and to this day are special to us. Needless to say, we have made very many wonderful friends over the past 17 years in the beardie agility community.

2015 RALLY RESULTS

Tabulations for the award for the "Top Dog" in each level of Rally start in January 1 and continue through December 31. In 2015 there were 278 qualifying legs earned by Beardies, an increase of 25 over 2014. To compute the award, all qualifying scores and placements of dogs in each class for all levels of Rally were taken into consideration. The statistics were taken from the 2015 AKC Rally quarterly reports.

BCCA members are eligible to receive the awards that will be presented at the 2016 National Awards Banquet, in Boxborough, Massachusetts.

To determine the "Top Dog" in each level, a point value is given to a dog's placement under two systems: average score and Shuman. The point values under each of the two systems are accumulated during the year, and the dog with the highest total in each level of Rally is awarded that year's "Top Dog" in his/her particular level. The scoring system was based on the methodology used for the "Top Dog" in obedience award. For 2015 there was a tie for the "Top Dog" in Advanced and Excellent. Prior to 2014 three systems were used to determine the Top Dog: average score, Shuman and Delaney.

In 2015, 31 Beardies titled in Rally Novice, 13 titled in Rally Advanced, 15 titled in Rally Excellent, 3 titled in Rally Advanced Excellent and 1 titled in Rally Advanced Excellent 2. Congratulations to all of you!

2015 OBEDIENCE AWARDS

The following obedience awards were inadvertently left out of the last issue of the Bulletin.

In 2015, 22 Beardies earned qualifying scores and 15 received the Beginner Novice title; 2 Beardies earned qualifying scores in Pre-Novice; 20 Beardies earned qualifying scores and 9 titled at the Novice level; 2 Beardies qualified in Pre-Open; 7 Beardies qualified and 1 titled at the Open level; 3 Beardies earned qualifying scores and 2 Beardies titled at the Utility Dog level.

The "Top Obedience Dog Award" is given at each obedience level and computed as follows: a point value is assigned to a dog's placement under each of the following point systems - Average scores, and Shuman System. Average scores are calculated from the scores of all qualifying legs earned during the calendar year. The Shuman System assigns a point value for each qualifying scores. Dogs are assigned a point value (i.e. the beardedie with the highest average score would be 1st place and earns 10 points, the next highest score would earn 9 points, and so on. All dogs with the same score will be assigned the same point value). The point values accumulated by a dog under each of the systems are totaled for the year. The dog with the highest total in each of the levels is awarded that year's Top Dog for that particular level. Each year's tabulations begin on January 1 and include qualifying scores through December 31. All statistics necessary to perform these calculations are obtained from AKC. Only members of the BCCA are eligible to receive annual BCCA Obedience Awards which are presented at the Awards Banquet at the National Specialty. The top ten Beardies in each level are listed below along with their scores. Due to fewer dogs competing in the some classes, the top ten ranking is proportionately less.

JUNE 12, 2016 AKC DELEGATE MEETING

Kathy Coxwell, AKC Delegate

The Delegate Body of the American Kennel Club held its quarterly meeting on June 12, 2016 at the Hilton Doubletree Inn at the Newark Liberty International Airport, Newark New Jersey. The meeting was called to order by the President Dennis Sprung. The following are the highlights of that meeting as well as the Parent Club meeting held on June 11, 2016.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

There was a celebration of National Purebred Dog Day with multiple postings on Facebook and Instagram. This campaign

highlighted the importance and benefits of purebred dogs through compelling images, videos and themes.

We now have a rich portfolio of e-newsletters with a combined readership of 2.25 million. Quizzes about breeds and Groups have been among the highest performing, reaching hundreds of thousands of people across multiple channels.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

A list of all dogs disqualified over the last 5 years will be sent to all superintendents and show secretaries. It will be updated on a regular basis. A new accident policy was taken out to cover

judges at all approved AKC events. This is in addition to the existing AKC liability policy for judges.

Whenever a dog is disqualified, it must immediately leave the venue and the same is true following the reinstatement procedure. In these situations, the owner or handler is asked to use a DNA swab. If the dog is not DNA-ed, it will be ineligible for reinstatement. In addition, at the time of reinstatement, the dog will again be DNA-ed. There will be a \$500 processing fee cover costs.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The total revenues of \$27 million dollars for the first five months of this year were \$2 million or an overall increase of eight percent above 2015. Comparing our year to date core registrations volumes, we have registered 92,000 litters, which reflects a 7 percent increase and 228,000 dogs, which reflects and 11 percent increase.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PARENT CLUB COMMITTEE

DISASTER TRAILERS: Trailers have been delivered to 23 states. 328 clubs are participating and have raised \$978,238 in donations, along with the \$250,000 funded by AKC Reunite, with total funds raised of \$1,228,238. Forty-seven trailers have been delivered with nine more to be delivered shortly. Sixteen clubs are working on additional trailers.

PARENT CLUB OF EXCELLENCE: A survey project done by a sub-committee of the Parent Club Committee. The purpose was to help Parent Clubs self-evaluate and provide statistics to the Parent Club Committee so that the PC Committee might assist Parent Clubs in being more helpful to their members. Fifty-six clubs participated.

SPECIALTY SHOW EMAIL CAMPAIGN: Program created to help drive an increase in specialty entries. Proposal made that AKC do emails for dog shows as well as matches and send to people within a 200 mile radius who have registered dogs of that breed.

CAMPAIGN TO GET MORE PARENT CLUBS TO JOIN AKC: Suggested that an email campaign should be incentive for Parent Clubs who are not members of AKC to become members,

SHOWING SPAYED AND NEUTERED DOGS: Larry Sorenson stated that perhaps field trial champions should be able to move forward to compete for Best of Breed at Specialties. Such a proposal would have to go to the Rules Committee.

GROUP REALIGNMENT: The committee has not been officially disbanded. The most difficult problem was lack of response from Parent Clubs as to the group in which their breed should be placed and the committee being faulted for said placement.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Maribeth O'Neill spoke about the steady decline in Junior Showmanship entries since 2008. An email will go to all clubs asking what they are doing to increase Juniors participation.
