## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to Bearded Collies fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six (6) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

## OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a soccer turf surface in a 90' X 110" ring.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form. Please check your confirmation! Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

## OPENING/CLOSING DATES & MOVE-UPS

Entries open Monday, May 2, 2018, at 8AM and close Friday, June 1, 2018, at 6PM (Central). Move-ups will be accepted in writing or by email at the trial secretary's address until Monday, June 11, 2018 at 9PM (Central).

## MEASURING & HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to trial secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may compete, but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class(es). When filling out the entry form, there is a new section for exhibitors to designate whether or not their dog needs to be officially measured. If applicable, check the box so that the trial secretary knows to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List* for the judge. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct classes and height divisions.

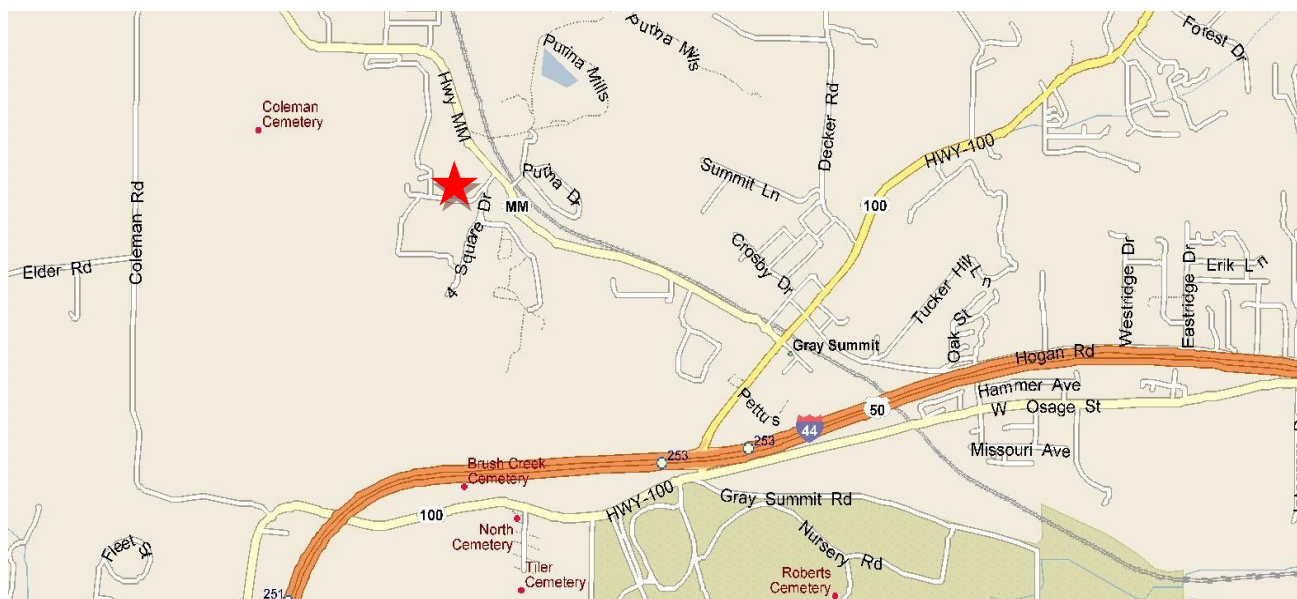

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

**FROM NORTH/EAST/SOUTH:** Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 (exit 253). Turn east on Hwy 100. Go ½ mile and turn left on MM. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1 mile on the left.

**FROM WEST:** Take I-70 to Hwy 47 (exit 193). Take Hwy 47 South to Hwy 100. Continue on Hwy 100 to I-44 East. Take I-44 East for one exit to Gray Summit (exit 253). Turn east on Hwy 100. Go ½ mile and turn left on MM. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1 mile on the left.



## PURINA FARMS INFORMATION

Ring size is 90' x 110' each (2 rings). Arena is air-conditioned with indoor restrooms.

If you plan to crate your dog, you **MUST** sign up for a Campsite at [beardiecamp.com](http://beardiecamp.com). Campsites are 8X10 and can certainly be shared if you like. Crates must stay in the assigned area since other things may be going on during the trial.

Please bring water for your dog(s), as well as clean-up supplies. Ex-pens are permitted ONLY within your campsite. **ALL CRATES MUST BE ON A MAT.** No dogs may be left overnight.

Exhibitors may set up their campsites on Monday, June 18, beginning at 2:30PM.

The Checkerboard Café provides food service. Be sure to mark the [Online Registration Form](#) for evening meals. No outside food is allowed on the property; only small coolers for treats are allowed.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Bearded Collie Club of America (BCCA) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The BCCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BCCA or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

### **REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. The club will refund 90% of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The trial secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter, hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked at least thirty (30) minutes before the trial commences.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). The RV area at Purina Farms is considered part of the show site. Exhibitors staying on the grounds are expected to clean up after their dog(s) and behave in a sportsman-like manner. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

### **RINGSIDE**

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. Dogs must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The BCCA has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

## JUDGING TIMES

Move in and set up begins at 2:00PM on Monday, June 18. On Tuesday, check in begins at 8:00AM with the first walkthrough/briefing at 8:45AM, and judging to begin at 9:00AM. On Wednesday, check in begins at 8AM with walkthrough/briefing at 8:45AM, and judging to begin at 9:00AM. Jeff Ipser will judge all classes offered at these trials. The TUMPS game will begin approximately 60 minutes after the last qualifying run of the day on Tuesday, and the RELAY will begin approximately 60 minutes after the last qualifying run of the day on Wednesday.

## WALK-THRU & WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog during a walk-thru period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-thru is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. **Walk-throughs will start 15 minutes prior to the judging of each class.** A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump is provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

## AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st-4th placements in all STD, JWW, and T2B classes along with flat ribbons for all qualifying runs. MACH, PACH, and PAX rosettes and bars will be awarded to all dog and handler teams who attain each title.

## VOLUNTEER WORKER INFORMATION

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular filling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. 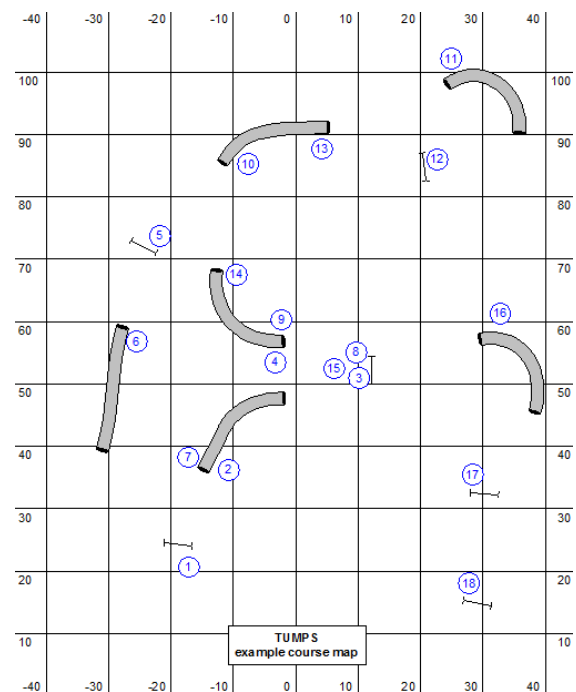
## GAME: TUMPS

Our special attraction on Tuesday will be a fun game that will begin after the regular trial events for the day have finished. Any Beardie and handler with agility experience may participate in the TUMPS (Tunnels and Jumps) game. The course will consist of 6 jumps and 6 tunnels that are repeated so as to produce a complete course of 18 obstacles. It is scored like Time to Beat, where all dogs of the same jump height compete together regardless of their level, and the course time is set by the fastest dog.

Strip ribbons for 1st-4th place will be awarded in each jump height. Cost is \$5/person.

This game is swift and fun! Imagine your Beardie running through 8-10 tunnels in one course! [Here's a video](#) that will give you an idea of how the game looks.

## GAME: TEAM RELAY

Our special attraction on Wednesday will be a fun relay game that will begin after the regular trial events for the day have finished. Teams of 3 handlers and their Beardies compete on a course consisting of tunnels and 16" jumps. Each handler on a team completes the course with his Beardie, handing off a baton to the next handler on the team. The team with the fastest time minus any faults wins. Dropped bars are faulted 5 seconds. Any Beardie and handler with agility experience may participate in the Relay.

Strip ribbons for 1st-4th place teams will be awarded. Cost is \$5/person.

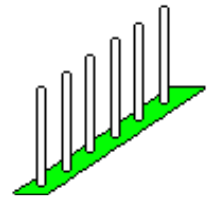
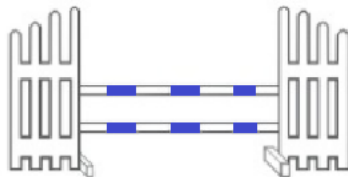
