The BEARDED COLLIE is a shaggy-appearing, medium-sized dog with a medium-length coat, weighing from 35 to 55 pounds. The outer coat is flat and harsh. The undercoat is soft and furry. The Beardie has a long, lean body, with a bright, inquiring expression that is a distinctive feature of the breed.

Beardies can be shades of BLACK, BROWN, FAWN, BLUE (blue-grey), with or without white markings on the face, neck, chest, paws, forelegs, and tip of tail. They can also be primarily white with splashes of black, brown, blue or fawn on the body.
