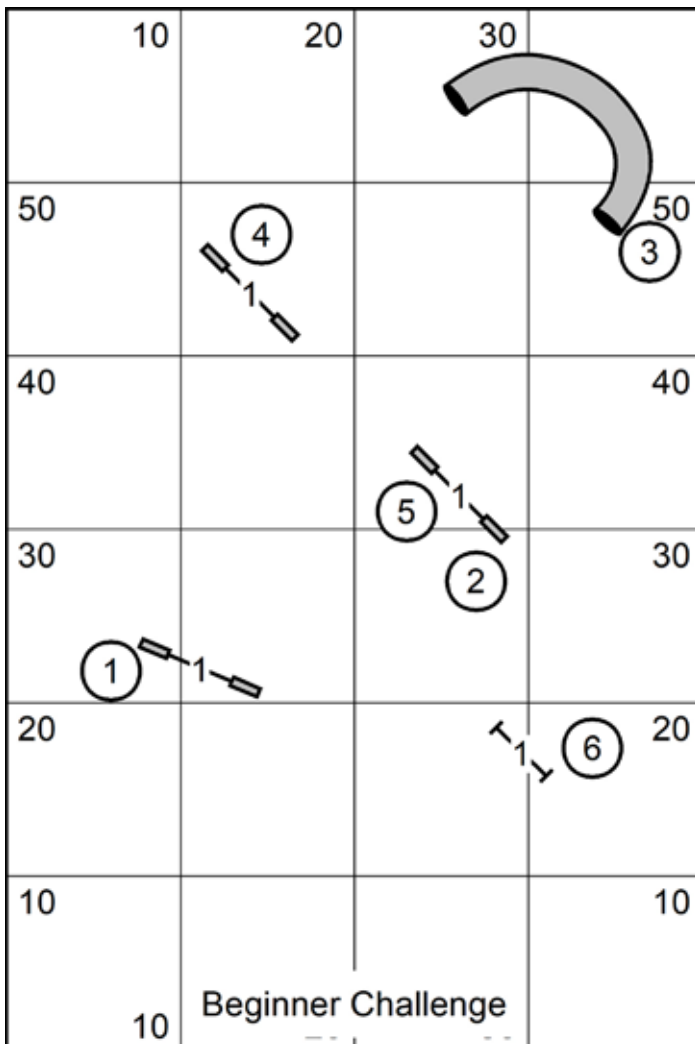




SMALL SPACE HANDLING SEQUENCE

Thank you to the Bearded Collie Club of America for allowing me to share a few training sequences in the absence of the 2020 National Specialty.



I have provided three sequences based on a Premier Standard course I designed for a trial in the St. Louis area – near where the 2021 Bearded Collie Specialty will be happening.

I have provided the complete Premier Standard Course, it was a fun course to watch teams negotiate. The AKC Premier Courses are designed to pose a series of challenges for the dog and handler team to negotiate. On a typical agility day, judges have to design and set up 10 courses, so we do our best to nest the courses together so as to provide a varying level of challenges using very similar obstacle arrangements.

In the additional figures, I am doing some obstacle substitutions to reconstruct the tunnel sequence in the upper portion of the course to give you some opportunities to set up a similar handling challenge for the various levels provided in AKC Agility.

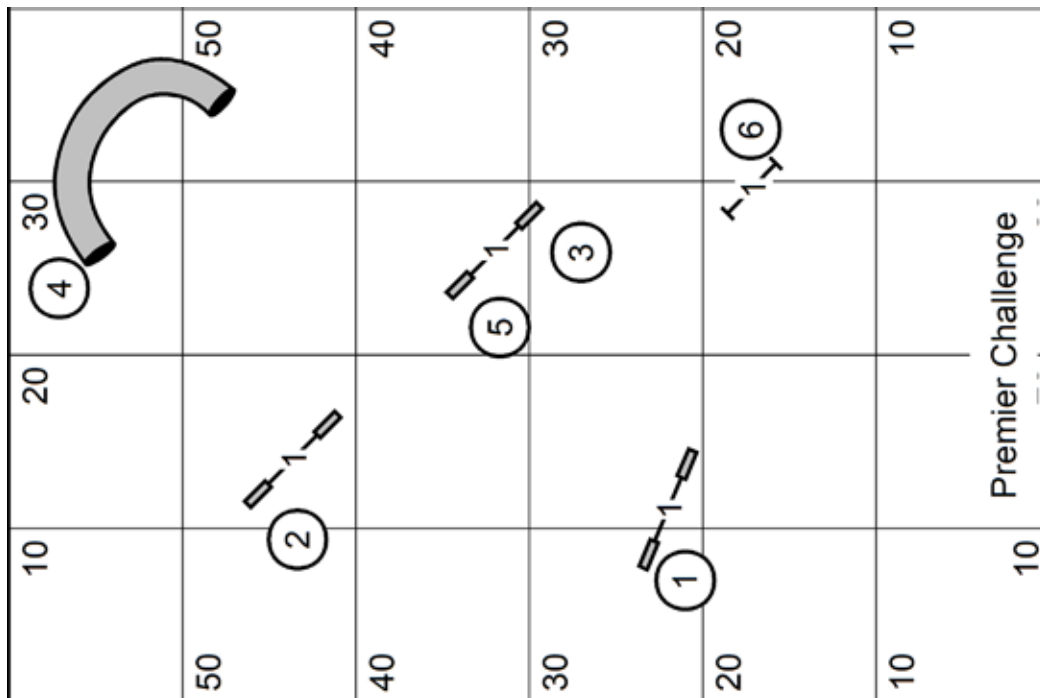
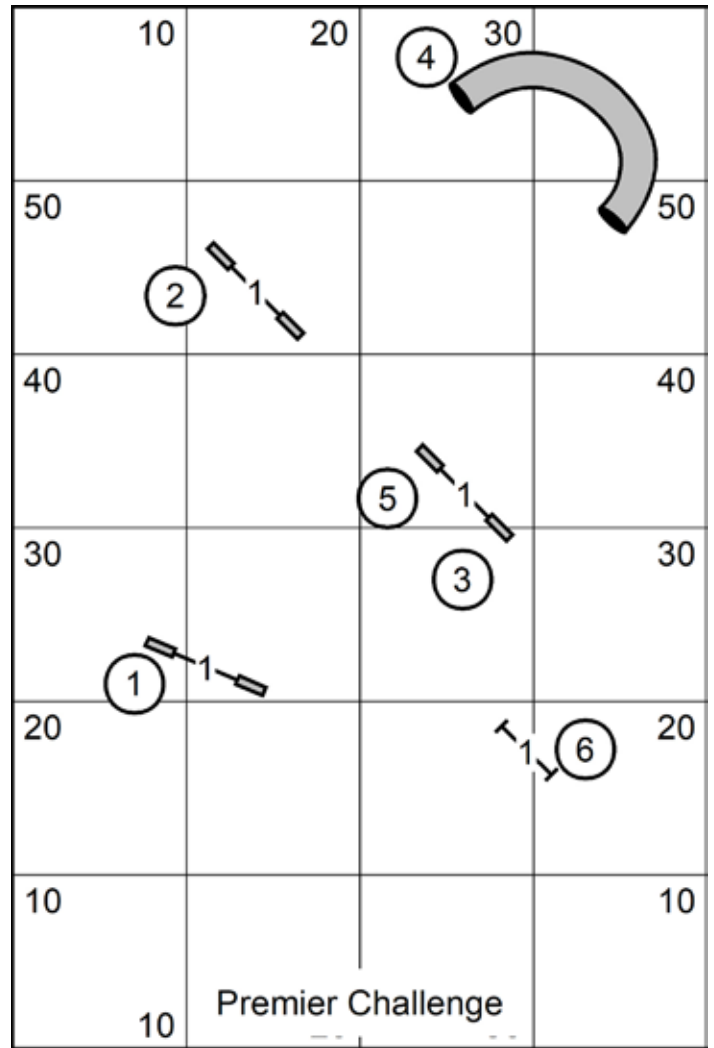
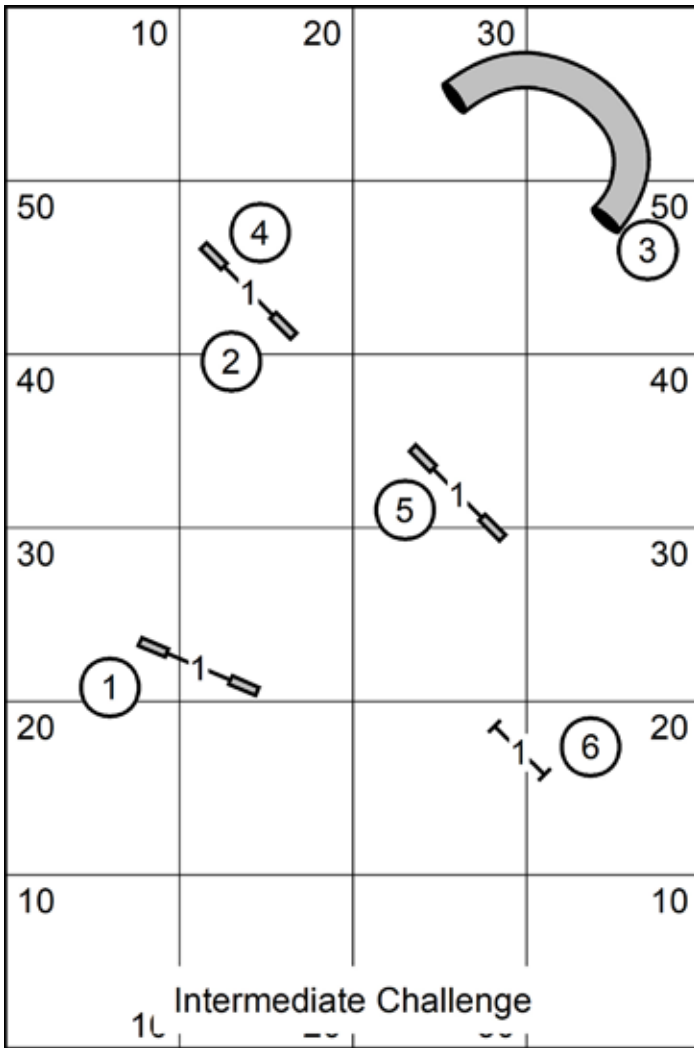
The Beginner Challenge is a basic sequence that can be run with only one side switch, and only presents the team with one off-course potential after jump #five. A standard way to handle this sequence is to start with the dog on the right from obstacles one - four, then do a front cross after jump four to complete the rest of the sequence.

The Intermediate challenge is best run with two side switches, and presents two off-course potentials. A typical way to handle this sequence is to start with dog on left, rear cross the tunnel #three, then do a front cross between #four and #five.

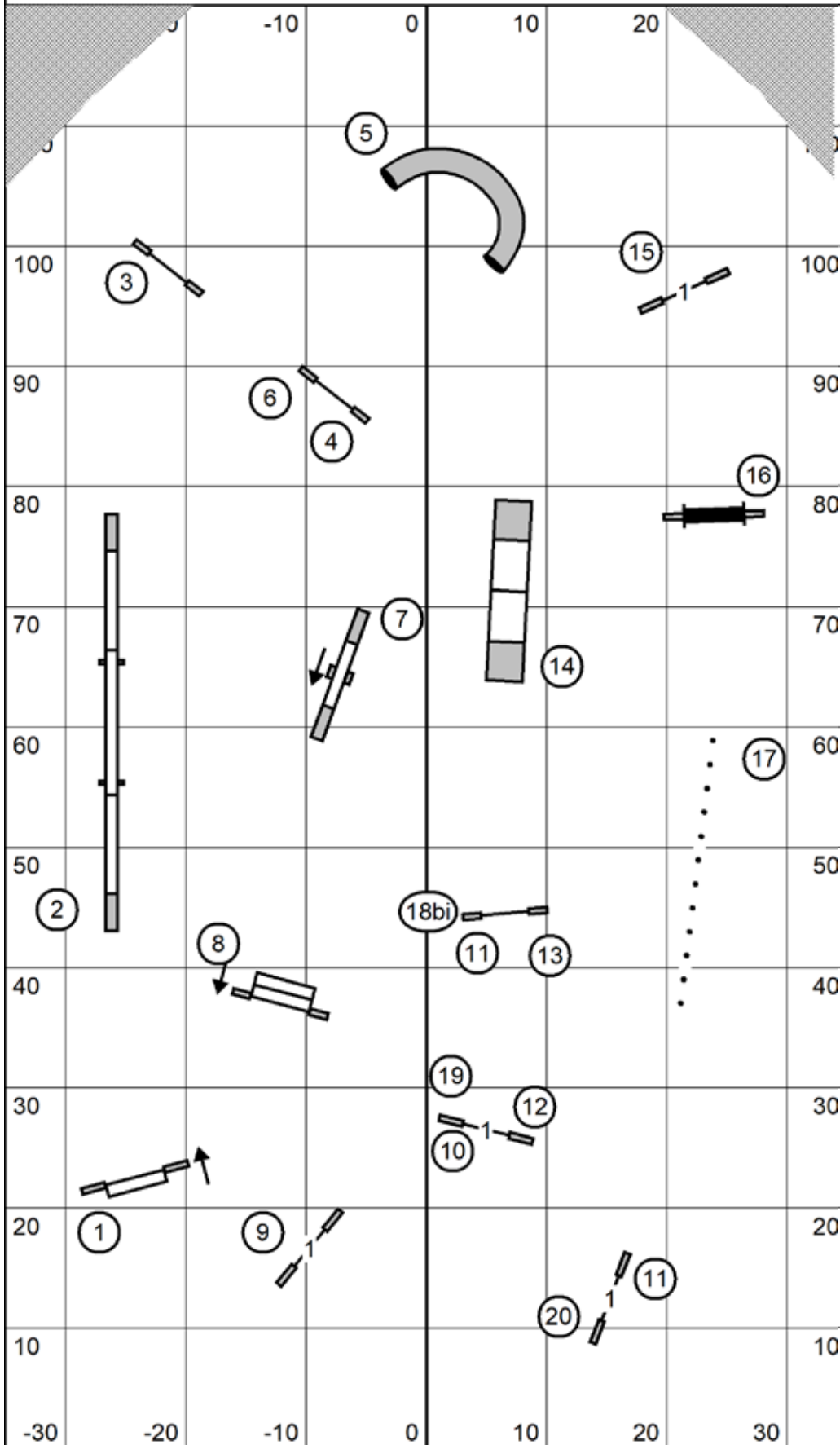
The Premier Challenge can be run a number of different ways, so the number of side switches a handler chooses can vary. In this sequence, there are four off-course potentials. If I were running this course with one of my miniature poodles, I would start with dog on left, then do a take-off side threadle cue with my right hand to call the dog between the gap of two and three, and use my right hand to send the dog over jump three and on to the tunnel. From there, I would stand on the takeoff side of jumps two and five/three and call my dog between the jumps. From there, I would rotate clockwise to get my dog on my left to complete obstacles five and six.

I hope you agility folks have enjoyed reviewing these sequences, and that you have a chance to try them out, possibly running them all a number of different ways!

The % is higher for the earlier years as the youngest have yet to enter breeding programs. As each year’s stats are updated there will be an increase in the number who have been bred.

KNOWLEDGE GAINED

- On average, there are about 50% more bitches who are bred than dogs.
- At most, 20% of bitches and 11.4% of dogs born in this time frame were used for breeding.

FOR DISCUSSION

- With the recent Embark program participation by the BCCA, it is possible to learn about the molecular diversity of an individual animal. Could it be that some of the dogs or

bitches not yet used in breeding and who remain intact could contribute to the diversity pool? If so, then encouraging/supporting Embark panel testing on these dogs might be a useful endeavor.

KNOWLEDGE GAINED

Documentation of declining number of litters and pups since 2008. These are how it all started.

1976 (pre AKC recognition). Litters 34; pups 202

1977 (year of AKC recognition). Litters 85; pups 496

Relatively consistent percentage of pups (70% range) have been individually registered in recent years. This is well above average for all AKC breeds (range 27% - 43%) and for all herding breeds (range 29% - 42%).

Foreign registrations contribute to the breeding pool

Of the imported dogs (sires & dams), 12-54% of them produced litters through 2017

An average of 20.3% of litters were produced by imported animals regardless of year of import. The range was 9.4% to 33.3% with the trend towards a higher percentage in more recently.

POSSIBLE DISCUSSION TOPICS

- How was the high percentage of registrations achieved?
- What reasons may have contributed to the recent decline in litters?
- Should the decline be addressed? Is it being addressed? How?
- If one reason for the increasing percentage of litters produced by imported dogs has been to increase genetic diversity (based on pedigree calculations of inbreeding coefficient), do we know if that has happened?

To find out it would be necessary to have the identification of individually registered dogs in years preceding and following 2008. Those data are unavailable from AKC at least directly. It is expected that Dr. Jerry Bell will be provided those data by AKC for his analysis of genetic diversity in the breed as he prepares a presentation for the fall 2021 specialty in Washington state.

- What would be a suitable discussion forum for these topics?
