THE 2019 AGI WAS TRULY A LOT OF FUN

This was Team Szaffi's first time qualifying and I am so very happy we went. It was an honor to represent Beardies and rewarding to be among the elite Beardie handlers. The Orlando Exposition Center is impressive and finding one's way around was challenging. There were quite a few fellow classmates there from Pinnacle Dog Sports (where I teach and train) that took the time to show the "newbie" around.

I had no expectations but set a goal of having at least one clear run. I wasn't fully aware of all the subtleties but knew that I had to complete the run to get points and that clean runs earned a rosette. My focus was to get at least one rosette.

The first run, Szaffi was totally amped up and blew her start line stay. I was barely able to recover but finished clean. Goal #1 achieved! We earned a rosette and 100 points.

Run #2 course was scheduled for later that afternoon. We had a nice start to the run but Szaffi slipped on the turf and although she was able to regain her footing, her gait was a bit off and she dropped the second last jump bar. Still, we finished the course with 1 fault and a score of 95.

The 3rd round was scheduled for early Sunday morning. This was the most challenging course with a particularly difficult weave entry. My strategy was to take my time and get another clear run if possible. Szaffi was dead on and handled the course like a pro. I was ecstatic and so very proud of her! As an aside, when you submit your entry, you also submit "talking points" that the announcer reads during one of your runs. Of all runs, this is the one they chose to read her biography. I recall hearing them announce that she was from Hungary and that she had recently earned her MACH 3. The moment was somewhat surreal and I found myself divided between listening and handling the course. Thank heavens Szaffi had her head in the game. One more clean run in the books and another 100 points. The final run of the day was scheduled for late afternoon. By this time, I was perfectly content with our accomplishments and would have gladly gone home a happy camper.

The final run was a intertwined maze of pinwheels that surely tested your memory. And just to make things "interesting" there was a hairpin backside early on in the course. Having only dabbled in Premier, I wasn't sure if we could pull this one off. You could hear the concern and distress from the other handlers as we walked. This was going to truly be a test of your handling and teamwork.

I was standing in the que, about eight dogs out, when I overheard two older handlers lamenting about the backside on the course. They were at the practice jump and were at a loss as to how to handle the maneuver. My instructor mode kicked in and I stepped out of line and ran over to the practice area. I handed Szaffi off to one of the ladies and said "Give me your dog". I went through the motions of how to handle a backside, demonstrated that their dogs could do it and then watched them execute perfect backsides. I ran back to the line just as they were calling our number realizing that I had no idea what the course was or what I had planned earlier. Fortunately, I was able to watch the handler ahead of me and was able to recall the course and what I had planned. At least that is what I hoped.

Again, Szaffi did not disappoint and made me look as if I actually knew what I was doing. Clean run # four, 100 more points, and a third rosette!

Afterwards, I went to claim my last award and as I started to walk away, they called me back and asked me if I wanted our Breed Medallion. I wasn't sure but said OK. Unbeknownst, to me, Team Szaffi had placed first! I was stunned! Remember, all I wanted was to earn only one clear run rosette.

In all, we scored 395 points and came in 30th overall in a 20" class of 128 as I recall.

I can't even begin to explain how grateful I am to have the opportunity to have this Special Beardie girl as a teammate. Her grace and elegance is only exceeded by her work ethic and patience with a less than worthy handler.

Thank you Kriszta Heger and my Wookiee Gang family for all your support, Special thanks to Rosanna for putting up with an agility addict.

MOST TITLED BEARDIE? . . . AND A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY ALONG THE WAY . . .

Someone posed the question on Facebook of which Beardedie might have earned the most titles. I wrote back that it depends on how you frame the question: most titled in a single venue/organization, multiple venues, or one or more sanctioning organizations in one or more venues? Also there is a historical aspect to the question because the number of titles available for Beardies to earn has increased dramatically over time, especially since 2011 in AKC, so it isn't really fair to try and compare the number of titles achieved by a Beardedie competing in the 1980's to about 2004 to those competing today. I decided to try and answer this question from a versatility standpoint which means I looked at AKC titles only. To pick out the appropriate time periods to examine, I first made a timeline of AKC titling opportunities for Beardies.

AKC Titling Timeline

Items in bold represent significant increases in AKC titling opportunities.

Items in italic are significant events in BCCA history.

a new conformation title is introduced, GCH.

AKC accepts therapy titles as a part of a dog's permanent record; five titles, based on service hours, are available.

AKC sets up its own Scent Work program; 49 titles are available to be earned.
AKC set up its own Trick Dog Program (four titles available).
Rally adds three new titles: RI, RM and RACH. RM and RACH can be earned multiple times.
- 2018 D course and its associated three levels of titles added to the AKC herding program.**
- 2019 multiple changes . . .**
AKC adds an additional outside organization to its titling opportunities:
Disc Dog (ten titles).
AKC sets up its own temperament test title (ATT)
- 2020...** In response to the pandemic emergency, AKC allows Trick Dog, ACT1/ACT2 agility titles and RN/RI rally titles to be earned by video evaluation until December 31, 2020.
- As of 2020, an unlimited number of titles can be earned in the following venues: agility, barn hunt, conformation, coursing ability, FAST CAT, obedience and rally. More than five, but not an unlimited number of titles, can be earned in disc dog (ten), dock diving (30), herding (47), and scent work (49). Venues with five or fewer titles available include: Canine Good Citizen, fly ball, search and rescue, temperament test, therapy, tracking and trick dog. Seven additional . . . titles can be earned by titling in multiple AKC venues.
 For versatility award purposes, agility, conformation, herding, obedience, rally, therapy and tracking are treated as stand-alone venues as they are all represented by a BCCA standing committee. Titles earned in barn hunt, coursing ability, disc dog, dock diving, FDC, Fast CAT, flyball, scent work, search and rescue, temperament test and trick dog are grouped together in a single venue, miscellaneous. All titles maintained in a dog's permanent record by AKC are counted for versatility award purposes but in those venues where there are two parallel tracks, regular and preferred, as there are in agility and obedience, only the track where the dog has the highest level of titles is counted towards any versatility award. Also for the VX award, a maximum of five titles from any one venue can be counted towards the required ten; for the VM award, a maximum of six titles from any one venue can be counted toward the required 15 with the required performance championship in that venue not counted towards the title number total. *For the purpose of this*

article, however, all titles leading to AKC title certificates will be counted even those in parallel tracks. It needs to be remembered as well that versatility awards were not automatic until about 2014; a member had to send copies of their qualifying title certificates to the versatility chair to receive an award. I scoured all the BCCA records I could get hold of to put together a database of past versatility award recipients. I believe the data is entirely complete from 1998 on but the available records from 1990-1997 were not as complete. I tried to fill in the gaps prior from scanning all of the Bulletins for multiple titled Beardies but I could have missed one or more, especially if the owner never advertised their dog's accomplishments.

Prior to 1990, a Beardie competing in AKC events had to title in multiple venues to be in the running for most titled as the only titles available to them were one conformation title (CH), four obedience titles (CD, CDX, UD, OTCH), two tracking titles (TD, TDX) and the honorary BCCA title, HIC (herding instinct).

Of the Beardies who exhibited prior to the establishment of the BCCA versatility program in 1987, the most titled appears to have been CH OTCH Windcache A Briery Bess HIC owned and handled by Barbara Prescott. Bess was the first Beardie to earn an OTCH. I met Bess and Barbara at the 1985 BCCA National Specialty and practiced stays with them with my first Beardie, Dworkin, who was entered in Novice A. I believe Bess passed away not long after that National.

Of the Beardies earning a versatility award in 1987-1989, the most titled was CH Raggmop Leading Lady UD TDX HIC, owned by Toni Tuck, who qualified for seven of the eight titles available to them at the time.

AKC Herding titles came on-line in 1990 and AKC standard agility titles in 1994, increasing the total number of titles to 17. HIC continued to count towards a versatility award if it was earned before 1995. Twelve versatility awards were given in the period 1990-1994 but the maximum number of titles earned by any of these new multi-titled Beardies was four, so Toni and Leading Lady remained the most titled versatility award winners through this period as well.

Between 1994-1998, no new venues were added but tracking, obedience and herding each added one or more titles and agility doubled its title number to eight with the introduction of the Jumpers With Weaves (JWW) class. This made a total of 25 titles available. Of the Beardies earning a versatility award in this time period, **Sharon Prassa and Moonsong Klassical Legacy CDX HS MX MXJ (13 total) and Toni Tuck and CH Britannia Peppermint Patty UD TD HT MX AXJ (13 total)** were tied as the most titled versatility teams. Toni and Patty were the first Beardie team to earn at least one title in all five venues with titles at that time (agility, conformation, herding, obedience, tracking).

Between 1999 and 2004, many changes occurred in AKC titling. Agility expanded its offerings with MACH and the new preferred track with the first unlimited Master titles. Available herding titles increased about six fold with the addition of course and/or stock specific titles. Versatility companion dog titles (VCD) were made available to those titling in obedience, agility, and tracking after 2001.

The first team to earn the Master Of Versatility award was **Sandy**

Weiss and DC Britannia Chip Thrills UD HS HI HX HXAs AX AXJ (THD CGC) who achieved this milestone in 2000. Chip would go on to complete a total of 23 titles in his show career including a UDX, MX and MXJ.

Jan and Tony Vallone's CH Blackfriar A Scot On The Rocks CD MX MXJ MXP2 MJP3, a Versatility Excellent award winner in 2002, **had 21 titles total,** the most of all the versatility award qualifiers from 1999-2004. She and Jan later added an RAE2 and PAX for a total of 27 titles in her career.

The pace of change in the titling arena increased yet again between 2005 and 2010. Rally became an AKC titling sport offering four titles. The agility program added another class, FAST and its associated titles, and recognized accomplishments at the master level in the preferred track with PAX (20 QQs; that was awarded retroactively to 2002) and in combined performance in the standard, JWW and FAST classes with the title TQX/TQXP. Obedience Master (OM) was added to the obedience title list but was not made retroactive; it can be earned up to ten times. Finally, conformation added a new title, Grand Champion (GCH), to encourage exhibitors to continue showing their finished dogs. Three Beardies completed Master awards in this time period. Of these, my Flash, **CH MACH Britannia Flashback CD RAE HSAds HIAs HXAs MX MXJ OAP AJP MXF XFP earned the most titles with 31** and was the first Beardie with a MACH to complete a Master of Versatility award; Flash and I continued to show in agility and herding until 2014 and ended his show career with a total of 60 AKC titles. Another notable Versatility Excellent award winner from this period is **OTCH MACH O'Duinnin Oh Dat Jack B Nimble UDX3 RE owned by Jill Scarborough, the only Beardie to earn both an OTCH and a MACH.**

The period from 2011 to the present has likely been the source of more changes to AKC titling programs than all the years previous! Agility introduced three new classes and their associated titles (Time 2 Beat, Premier Standard and Premier JWW). Titling opportunities were also added to classes/tracks already in place including PACH (Preferred Agility Champion that was awarded retroactively to 2002), lifetime titles in both tracks of standard, JWW and FAST (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Century) that were made retroactive to the beginning of the AKC agility program, and finally, agility Grand Champion (AGCH). Lifetime titles became a part of the conformation program (GCHB, GCHS, GCHG, GCHP - multiple). Herding added Master titles for every course/stock combination on request, a new course, D, and its associated titles, and a CGC behavior test, farm dog certification (FDC), carried out in a farm setting. Obedience added a second track of titling classes, preferred, and turned a number of non-regular classes into a new optional titling track (Beginner Novice, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open and Versatility), the most successful of which has been Beginner Novice (BN). Rally added three new titles: RI, RM and RACH. Therapy became a titling activity as a separate venue in the versatility award program. Tracking introduced a new title, tracking dog urban (TDU). The Miscellaneous venue of BCCA versatility was populated with activities by several AKC actions. Coursing ability, Fast CAT, temperament test (ATT) and trick dog became all breed titling opportunities. AKC agreed to list titles from several outside organizations as a part of a dog's permanent record; the activities covered by

these agreements include barn hunt, disc dog, dock diving and flyball. Canine Good Citizen (CGC) titles were cleared to be added to a dog's record, and the program created two new tests, Advanced (CGCA) and Urban (CGCU). Finally, AKC created its own scent work program that currently offers 49 titles. The requirements for BCCA versatility awards were revised in 2013 to reflect these increased titling activities and for the first time added limits on the number of titles from one venue that could be counted toward the Versatility Excellent and Master Awards; a requirement for at least one herding title was also added at the Master level.

Given this tremendous expansion of titles, it should come as no surprise that Beardies are earning more versatility awards than ever before. Between 1998 and 2010, six Beardies earned Master of Versatility awards; since 2011, seventeen Beardies became Versatility Masters with two additional in 2020 as yet unconfirmed by AKC. The interest in training and showing in multiple venues seems to have increased as the number of opportunities for titles has increased.

Debbie Alexander and CH MACH6 PACH2 Wynsum Queen Of Diamonds N' The Ruff CD BN RE HSAs FDC MXC2 MJB3 MXP6 MXPS MJP7 MJPS PAX2 MFG TQX MFPB TQXP T2B4 CGC TKA have the distinction of being the MV award holder with the most current titles, 79 earned in six versatility venues.

Sonja Blanchard and GCH DC Lil'Clove True Grit VCD1 BN RAE TDX HSAdS HSBd HIAdS HIBd HXAdM MX MXJ MXP MJP XF CGC TKI have the honor of titling in the

most versatility venues, seven of the eight available.

Recognition as the current most titled versatility award holder goes to Jan Leverenz and CH AGCH MACH8 PACH3 Wynsum Rhythm And Brews BN RAE MXB4 PDS MJC3 MXP7 MXPB MJP7 MJPS PJDP PAX3 MFG TQX T2B5 CGC TKN with 88 titles; Jan and Smitty hold a Versatility Excellent award. Jan and Smitty also appear to be the overall most AKC titled Beardie team as well. The closest agility specialist team, Larry Dalan and Wigglesworth Pride And Prejudice, have a total of 74 titles, 73 of them earned in agility.

I have tried to demonstrate throughout this article that bragging rights for "most titled" depends very much on how you decide to count the titles and when you were actively competing. For this article, I chose the simple standard that one certificate equals one title. Some people might argue that once you have shown competence at an advanced level in a sport by achieving a Master title or have earned a herding title at any level on one type of course and stock, that going on and earning more titles is just "gilding the lily" and might choose not to consider such additional titles as notable. I think, however, that achieving a large title count in one or many venues requires both a financial commitment for training, entries, and travel, and the dedication of countless hours that deserve to be recognized. Furthermore, no Beardie earns dozens of titles over a show career without possessing qualities of reliable temperament and physical soundness we should all wish our dogs have.

So HUZZAH to all you multi-titled Beardies whether you trial in one venue or many! In my book, you're the best!
