## AKC REGISTRATION STATS FOR BEARDED COLLIES

This includes all of 2021 data.

Please note that this includes three new data sets:

1. For litter complements and dogs we now includes counts of earned Family Dog titles, titles earned through the Title Recognition Program (TRP) and an additional total count of those participating in all Sports and Events.
2. For Unique Dogs and Bitches Bred each year we now include a ratio of dogs to bitches, i.e., "Female:Male".
3. Rankings – we have included breed rankings by dog and litter registration

As we did in the 2021 mid-year stats, we are including Parent Club Membership data relating to breeder and litter counts. This data, from 2016 through 2021, gives a general picture of the breeding activity of Parent Club members relative to the overall breeding activity within the breed. **\*\*NOTE:** This data is only as accurate as the membership lists submitted by each Parent Club through the web-based Club Membership Upload Tool and our ability to use email addresses to match members to litters. To ensure accurate information for this and similar projects please make sure your membership data is current. If your club submits household data (not individuals) please note we are counting a household as a member.

As with previous distributions of the Parent Club Registration Stats data, please feel free to share the attached information with your club membership as you see fit in order to stimulate discussion about registration and possible changes or improvement initiatives per the original rationale for sharing (below).

Original rationale for this data sharing this information (from email dated 11/07/2017):

Although registration numbers have been on the rise now for a number of years after nearly two decades of continuous decline, some breeds are not rebounding as well as others. The Board and staff have discussed this matter, and we are reaching out to each Parent Club to determine how AKC registration processes and procedures can be improved to better support breeders and to explore how AKC could further assist Parent Clubs in their mission to develop and steward their breeds. Additionally, the Board has asked that certain registration information be shared with each Parent Club in order to provide a statistical snapshot of the current state of each breed and to stimulate discussion within and between clubs and staff regarding possible improvement initiatives.

### IMPORTANT NOTES

As noted in the previous distributions of this information, the attached includes the counts of litters, litter complement, and dogs registered for each year since 2008. The reports also include the counts of unique dogs and bitches that were bred or that participated in a sport. Those counts are finite and will change only minimally over time and generally only due to cancellations of litters, dogs and/or awards. However, the reports also contain numbers that are "To Date" which will often change each time we produce these statistics (see definition below).

Complement: This is the count of pups from each AKC litter.

To Date: There are a number of rows that indicate "to date," such as "Total Complement in Conformation (to date)." All rows with "to date" information are refreshed every time we reprocess this report. This is so you will have an accurate picture of the puppies produced in any given year. For instance, of the 1,498,458 puppies produced in AKC Litters in 2009 (a.k.a., the Litter Complement for 2009), 45,597 or 3% have thus far gone on to participate in conformation as of January 5, 2022. Every time we update this chart, the system looks at all litters from 2009 to see if any additional dogs have started in conformation. Obviously, there will not be many 2009 pups entering Conformation or Breeding for the first time in 2021, but there will be many updates to the information known about pups born in more recent years.

Unique: "Unique" indicates the number of individual dogs participating in an activity such as breeding or exhibiting, counting each unique dog only once. For example, the same dog might have participated multiple times in a sport during a single year, but is only counted as one unique dog for that entire year.

## HAPPY 25TH ANNIVERSARY TO BAD • APRIL 1, 2022

Our Bearded Agility On-Line Group started on March 14, 1997, hosted by Jim Cooper. It grew out of the search for our NADAC and USDAA Beardies. In the process, many of those I contacted felt that they would like to be in touch with one another. There was such interest, that we wanted to form our own group identity as Bearded Agility Enthusiasts. Within a week we held a contest to “Name That Line.” Karen Drummond suggested BAD and Gretchen Blackburn improvised on the theme with about 20 possible ways to define ourselves. We loved the acronym and decided to call ourselves BEARDIE AGILITY DIEHARDS. We adopted the name and began our BAD lives on April 1, 1997. It seems very apt that April Fools’ Day is our Name Day! Gretchen then offered to design our Logo, which was unveiled at the 1997 Nationals. Since then we have welcomed many agility enthusiasts, growing from 33 members and 38 Beardies in 1997 to 226 members and 618 Beardies in 2022. The BAD website

When Karen Norteman developed our website, which appeared on New Year's 1998, it was noticed within 12 hours and immediately given the Dogpatch Star Site Award.

Bud Houston of Clean Run wrote: "I've found the coolest agility web site in cyberspace. You MUST go check it out!" "You have a great web site. I hope more performance dog sites approach their web presence with such creativity and humor. I've known for a long time that Beardies are quite special. I had an agility student about ten years ago with a Beardie that weaved so very fast, and learned to do so in only about two weeks. In those days we didn't realize how fast weave poles could be done. But these days when I train my dog I train for the performance of that Beardie so many years ago. I'm waiting for one of this breed to take it all in national competition." (Which Leslie Dawson-North did in 1998 at the AKC Nationals with Chase!)

**Karen Barratt** wrote: "Wow! 25 years of wonderful memories. I have shown the BAD website to almost everyone I've known. It was and probably still is a showpiece for our breed achievements."

What a joy it has been to share with all of you for a quarter of a century. I remember the early letters and photos from Ann Chandoha, Karen Barrett, Jerry Bergen, Betty Winfield, Joanne Williamson, and Leslie Dawson-North, to name a few. I still have them all filed away. Ann Chandoha's Stoli wrote to me about being handled by a newbie. Since then she has earned 9 MACHs with 4 of her Beardies! When we started, the only AKC class available was Standard and the highest title was a Masters Standard title. Several among us were already doing USDAA which had Standard, Jumper, Gamblers, Snooker, and Pairs as well as many games just for fun, such as Strategic Pairs and Sweepstakes. To qualify for Nationals, one had only to earn one Grand Prix leg. AKC's original agility advisors were the USDAA judges who helped shape agility into something more than running one's Beardie on one's left side through a series of obstacles arranged into a gentle loop. Yes, Novice Agility was something like an Obedience activity! Few handling skills were necessary. We watched as a whole new vocabulary developed for crosses, serpentines, and all kinds of maneuvers. Suddenly we had a Clean Run website and a magazine devoted exclusively to dog agility.

Did you know that the first ever AKC Specialty was for Beardies? We had a wonderful advocate in Judge Beth Canner who came from UKC agility.

**Beth Canner** wrote: "Wow!! What a great bunch of working, agile, bouncing Beardies performing in the agility ring at our Specialty. I was so proud to be a part of this agility event. The

Beardies were exceptional. The average amount of time the novice Beardies had spent on training was 3 months. That is a very short amount of time to train and still have such a great showing. Many of these Beardies actually never, I repeat, NEVER, had been on any REAL contact obstacles until the run-throughs on Saturday. And the amazing thing is they never flinched and just went about the course like they had been doing this forever. The handlers are to be commended also. Our course space was barely legal and very tight. That meant the handlers had to make tighter turns and had very little 'free' space. It was especially difficult for the higher classes of excellent and open, but the handlers were coool about it and if there were complaints, they never reached my ears. Good sportsmanship was in abundance. The audience was patient as we changed courses and congratulated each Beardie and handler after their run. 30 Beardies were entered in our Agility Trial. 28 ran and 12 qualified, which is actually above the average on qualifiers."

**Karen Barratt** wrote: "I so remember the 1996 specialty in Orlando. My Boo competed in that standard trial where all the obstacles were Disney themed and would be laughable today. Leslie Dawson North, Eileen Dinneen and I were, I think, the only ones with trained dogs. Most had never seen an agility course. There were only a handful of beardies doing agility. The sport was so new. I started training in 1995 before AKC so we trialed with USDAA. In those days 'Agility Gate' for us was courses hung on a wall and we stood in line waiting to trace them on our own paper."

*In 1996 the only class offered at the Nationals was Standard. In 1997 we added Jumpers as a "fun" class. By 1998 it had become a regular class. Once these two classes were in place the Championship program was added in early 1999, which demanded consistency in both Standard and Jumpers performance. Dogs are required to qualify in both Standard and JWW (Double Q's) on the same day at least twenty times. No matter how many legs a Beardie had already earned at the Masters level, he had to start over from scratch gathering new Master's legs and 750 points for seconds under the Standard Course Time.*

*Joanne Williamson's Sean was the first Beardie to fulfill all of the Master Agility Championship (MACH) requirements in June 2001. In 2007 the AKC added the FAST class, a type of gamble requiring distance work and the possibility of Triple Qualifiers for the TQX. Continuing to evolve, Time to Beat, a class based on competitive speed, was added in July 2011.*

*Then in July 2012, AKC instituted retroactive Lifetime Achievement titles, which recognize every Masters leg ever earned in Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, and FAST, both in the Regular and Preferred programs. Starting on October 1, 2015 the AKC introduced Premier classes to provide an opportunity for agility competitors to demonstrate different and more difficult handling skills than those required for the Master Level Classes in Standard and JWW.*

*Now the highest AKC title is the Agility Grand Championship, the AGCH, which requires 100 legs each of Masters Standard and JWW, 75 each of FAST and T2B, and 50 each of Premier Standard and Jumpers. To date three Beardies have earned the AGCH: Larry Dalan's Bing (CH AGCH MACH13 Wigglesworth Pride And Prejudice) on 23 October 2018, Jan Leverenz's*

*Smitty (CH MACH8 PACH4 Wynsum Rhythm And Brews) on 9 February 2020, and Jennifer Phillips' Ryan (CH AGCH MACH6 PACH) Estrella's Orion The Dark Hunter) on 6 February 2022.*

**Patsy Sullivan** wrote: "Yes I remember seeing the agility course at the Orlando Specialty in '96 which was set up indoors in a ballroom. Looked like so much fun for the dogs that I went home and found a training class in my area and have participated in agility in every Beardie specialty since that I could drive to."

Since the 2002 National Specialty in Monterey, California we have presented the Diehard Trophy each year at the annual BCCA Awards dinner to the agility Beardie with the highest accomplishments in AKC Masters Agility and JWW for the previous year.

BAD works closely with the BCCA Agility Committee and sends agility stories, statistics, and photos to the BCCA Bulletin and Bagpipes, where we receive great support from Lillian Esposito and Michele Ritter.

It has been an enormously rewarding experience sharing with all of you through so many years. We need to plan a celebration for our 25th Anniversary!
