FAST STRATEGY

FAST (Fifteen And Send Time) is the AKC version of a distance challenge class known as gamblers in other agility organizations. Unlike USDAA where a horn signals the exhibitor it is time to attempt the send sequence after accumulating opening points, the handler in FAST is free to attempt the send at any time on course and receives a 20 point bonus along with the obstacle points for completing it successfully but the send MUST be completed before the horn announces that the team's time is up (32 seconds for 20" regular and 35 seconds for 16" preferred) or that team does not receive a qualifying score. After the horn sounds, 1

point from the total accumulated on course is lost for every full second over the allowed time. There are always 6 one-point obstacles on the course, then obstacles pointed 2-10 points each for a total of 15, hence the name of the class. A perfect score is 80. 50 Points are required to qualify in Novice, 55 in Open and 60 in Master. The contacts most often seen are the A-frame and see saw but the dog walk can also be used. When the class was introduced in 2007, each skill level was held separately, but starting about 5 years ago, the levels were combined in an attempt to make the class take less time to run. Having to design

sends suitable for Novice, Open and Master on one course has simplified the type of distance challenges offered considerably to mainly jumps and tunnels, and the Novice dog is required to do 12 weave poles in order to get their points. In the past couple of years, judges have started pointing both the start AND finish jumps so that you must finish the course within the allowed time to get the finish jump points.

I have been competing in FAST since the class was introduced and greatly enjoy the challenge of controlling my dog's path at a distance. I'd like to share with you some of the generalizations I have developed over the years in picking a course path.

1. You need to have some idea of how quickly your bearded can get the obstacles done. If he/she has obstacles they are particularly slow on (the weave poles come to mind for many dogs) it may be a good idea to try to avoid these when planning your path.
2. Look at all the possible entries into the send when making a plan. Some routes to start the send make more sense than others. Planning back from the send entry can sometimes clarify the best overall path.
3. Look at the shape of the send line. If the send line comes out and then goes in, you need to take that in account when you make your plan. If you need to run left to get around a corner of the line, your dog will likely follow you, whether that suits where you need him/her to go or not!
4. Try to choose as flowing a path as possible. Abrupt starts and stops can be hard on a dog's body and don't always make sense to his/her mind. They can also waste time of which you don't have that much!
5. Try to plan to do the send as early as is reasonable. Remember the dog must finish the send before time runs out or you cannot qualify.
6. Be careful planning your path around the finish jump. Once your bearded goes over it, you are "finished" on course and must leave even if you've only just started!
7. Try not to retrace your path on course. Doing obstacles more than once unless necessary for flow doesn't often get you any extra points and wastes time.
8. Try to establish the working distance you need to get the send as early as possible on course. Running up to the line and then stopping dead in your tracks is not generally the best way to get your dog to move away from you...motion begets motion! You need some space from the line to get in a step or two after you start the send without going over the line,
9. Don't be afraid to learn from your competitors' performances, especially if it's a "head scratching" kind of course. Sometimes others have seen something you have not and have a better plan. But alternatively, you know your own dog better than anyone else. Don't be afraid to use a plan that differs from others if you think it plays to your team strengths.
10. Examine your FAST course for obstacle combinations that might come up later in the day on other courses. Often FAST is held first, as a warm-up class, and if your judge is nesting his/her courses to reduce course building time, you may get a chance to practice a sequence you will see again.

With these rules in mind, consider the two maps of FAST courses I have provided.

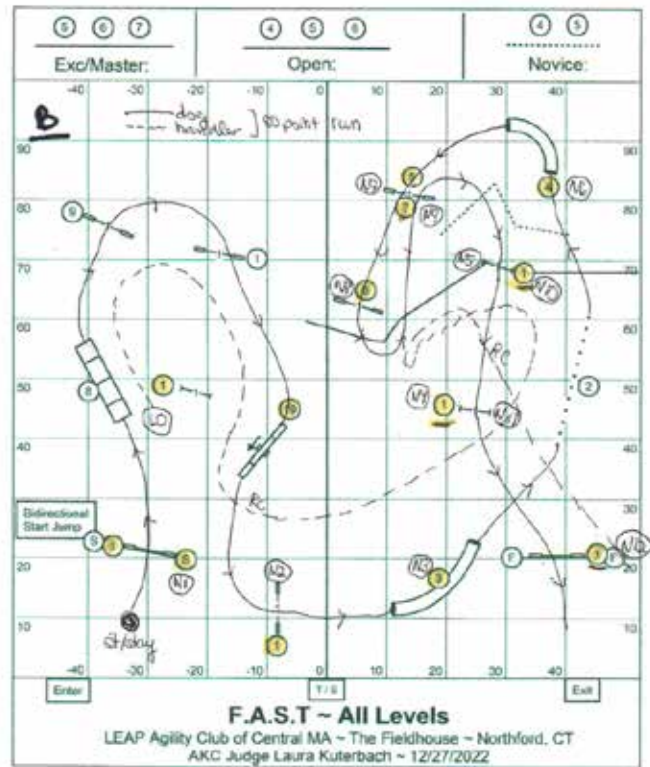
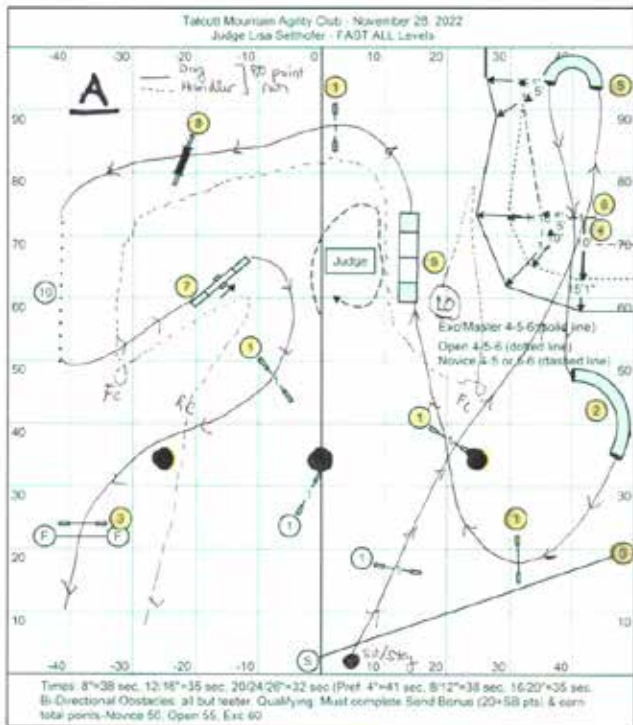
The start line of course A encompasses the right side of the ring so you have several options of where to start...this is uncommon in FAST courses these days...mostly one particular obstacle will be designated as the start obstacle as you will see in course B. At first glance, there don't seem to be many really good entrances to this send. And most of the high value obstacles (weave poles, panel jump, see saw, A-frame) whose points you need to qualify are on the opposite side of the ring from the send. The finish obstacle is also on the opposite side of the ring from the send. When I first looked at this course nothing much came to mind about how to start. I considered entering the send from the A-frame side facing the front of the ring but I couldn't see any reasonable way of getting from the start line to the back of the A-frame that didn't involve retracing our path to get to the send and then back to the finish. Fortunately for Truman and me, some exhibitors with conflicts (we were at a venue where multiple events were being held) got to run before we walked our course. Several of them left their dogs on the end of the start line near the center of the ring and went directly over the two 1-point jumps to the send. Although, this didn't work for all of them...some of their dogs dived into the 2-point tunnel on the way to the send and others took the wrong side of the send tunnel when the handler ran to the left to stay off the send line, I saw how I could make this start work for Truman (rule 9). We have an excellent sit/stay at the start of the course (if you read my last month's Bagpipes article, you might remember I advocated training a solid stay) which allowed me to lead out almost to the foot of the A-frame and establish myself well to the left of the send line. I set Truman up so he had a straight-line view over the two 1-point jumps to the 4-point jump of the send. I released him and started to move when he was collecting to take off for the second jump. My movement kept his attention forward and off the 2-point tunnel. As he approached the first jump of the send, I moved right and told him "out" to keep him on line with the correct (right end) of the tunnel. I stayed level with the 4/6 point jump to make sure he didn't miss it on the return then sent him to the near end of the 2-point tunnel. I told him "out" while he was in the tunnel as I was waiting for him on the landing side of jump-2 he had already taken in the opening. I picked him up on my right and we did the A-frame, 1-point jump, panel jump and weave poles. I then front crossed at the end of the poles and picked Tru up on my left to go to the see saw. I kept him on my left and did a post turn, rear crossing after he jumped and ran out to the finish jump with him on my right. We ended up with a perfect score of 80 using this path. I have also suggested a shorter path on this course which would allow a dog to qualify at all levels but does not involve doing the weave poles: these obstacle numbers are highlighted in yellow (S1, 1, 4, 5, 6, 2, 9, 1, 8, 7, 1, F3). Note that at the Novice level, there are two options offered for the send, 4-5 and 5-6. Given the course A set up, I would never choose 5-6 as an option as I think it would be very hard to get the far end of the tunnel first.

The start line of course B is more typical of courses these days, a single jump. The send is on the same side of the ring as the finish jump, so in this case it seemed to make more sense from both a flow perspective (rule 4) and avoiding back-tracking (rule 7) to wait and do the send later. As it turned out, jump-A-frame was the opening of our Master standard course that day, so I was happy that Truman and I could get to practice it in FAST (rule 10); the sequence configuration of the see saw was also

similar to the Master Standard course. I led out to the base of the A-frame and released Tru to the first jump. We did the A-frame-J9-J1-SS with dog on left. I then rear crossed after the SS and sent Tru to J1-T3-weave poles-T4-J5-J6 with dog on right, and I was waiting for Tru on the landing side of J6 to wrap back to J7. I asked him for a more collected turn to J1 because I did not want to waste time doing the tunnel again. We then did J1-J1 and I rear crossed on the take side of the second jump and went to the finish jump with dog on left. This path gave us a score of 80. I have also suggested a shorter path on this course which avoids the A-frame and weave poles that would allow qualification at all levels and has the obstacle points highlighted in yellow: S1, J1,

SS-10, J1, T3, J1, J1, T4, J5, J6, J7, J1, J1, F1. And for Novice only, there is a very short path available for qualification; these obstacles are marked in order, N1-N12.

One final thought. Always check your score sheet after you run FAST. Scribes often do not hear the judge properly and you can miss getting credit for obstacles or the bonus for the send. Even better get your FAST runs videoed so you have something to fall back on besides the judge's memory if there is a question. On the A course, my score sheet did not have the 6 circled. Fortunately for us, the 6-point obstacle was part of the send and as we had "bonus" circled, the judge was happy to correct the error!
