The shelter originally picked Jolene on 12/3/2020 and as no one claimed her in the legal time limit, they turned her over to the Humane Society of Wichita Falls, TX for placement. The HS, neutered her, gave her most of her shots, but could not place her because she growled at strangers coming to her crate. Because of this she was returned to Mineral Wells. She was very friendly, giving kisses to the workers at both shelters; she had not bitten anyone; she just did not like strangers coming to her kennel. She got along well with all the pit bulls in the kennels next to her. HS said she did not like cats. I had no problem with Jolene as I sat down in the play run, she came over to me wanting petting after a minute or two. I asked Kim to bring her to my car and put her in the crate since she knew her. Jolene took the treats and gave no problems on the trip home. She plays with my two beardedies and is just a youngster needing potty training. Otherwise she is great in the house.

Jacque came to the attention of Patty Halverson on 6/27/2021. She called the shelter and confirmed the dog was still there and could be viewed with an appointment later in the day. Lisa Depies, Coordinator for AZ and NM, was out of town so Patty Halverson contacted two local Beardie people she and Lisa personally know and trust to see if one could identify and pull him and one could keep him until Lisa returned to town. BCCA Member Tracy Corey is caring for him until Lisa is back in town. This data form is to reimburse Jackie Hoff for her \$300 expense. This shelter does not work with Rescues and it is a first-come-first-serve facility. Tracy is to scan and send all of his paperwork to me but as of yet I do not have it. It will all reside in his Dropbox file. He is to have a free vet visit which was included in his adoption fee. Shelter placed age at 4 but Tracy thinks he is older, maybe 8. Depending on his vet visit we may have more medical expense for him.

After intake, age (older than 4) and dental issues. The first vet visit included bloodwork, the cost of which was deducted from the cost of the dental procedures. He lost 6 teeth and required dental surgery. A photo of his teeth before the procedure is attached. the basic dental cost was \$575 and the additional charges are itemized with relations to extractions and other needed procedures. Jackie, Lisa Depies, and I discussed his dental needs in detail prior to the actual procedures. We all agreed everything cited was necessary to promote Jacques health and to rid him of pain.

After Lisa Depies returned to town, Tracy Corey who was temporarily fostering Jacques, turned him over to Jackie Hoff. Both Foster Agreements are on file in his file in Dropbox. Jackie took him to her vet for his initial evaluation. Bloodwork was done and his teeth evaluated, which resulted in his dental procedure. This invoice is on file in Dropbox under Jacques file.
