FY22 Activities, Accomplishments

 Hosted education at the 2022 BCCA National Specialty. No prospective judges were in attendance, so a more breeder/discussion oriented approach took place.

The entire program was 90 mins of discussion in a theater-style room, 60 mins of hands-on was conducted in the main show ring.

Many attendees signed up to participate without requesting materials. The charge was \$10 without materials

 Participated in the Triangle Judges Institute in March 2023. Part of a 4 days event with 11-12 breeds, we hosted 8 prospective judges for both a lecture style and hands on demonstration.

We only had one volunteer who was able to bring us a puppy to show the judges (thank you to Sarah Burke), otherwise we were only able to show Blue, Black and Brown adult dogs. We did have a shaved dog for the presentation which the judges found helpful and all reviews were positive.

These seem to be very effective for both the new judges and the breed clubs.

 BCCA also participated in an AKC venture creating breed videos during Royal Canine in Florida.

Future Considerations:

We should consider funding travel expenses and incentivizing local participants to bring a variety of dogs for judges to see.
