This has little to do with the capabilities of the dogs and more to do with the preferences of the owners. The BN title has drawn some teams into competition obedience, but most go no further than that title. Beardies competing at high level obedience are rare. Even rarer are those that track. Rally remains the preferred sport, although the numbers of participants goes significantly down after the novice level.
