6. July '14 - May '15 The Beardie Bulletin is profitable by \$3,668.

From Lillian: This report indicates that we can continue to do business as usual. However, advertising is down and each issue remains a challenge for me to obtain advertisers. It is not uncommon for me to sell pages after closing dates or discount pages in order to fill color forms. Based on the same 3 issues last year, 2014 we had a total of 146 advertising pages versus 120 pages this year. That is almost a drop of 20% in advertising. Not a good sign.

I would like to ad that Michele Ritter has been of great assistance in preparing a digital file for archival purposes for the BCCA, as well as submitting one file for each issue to our printer.

Web Statistics:

The website currently has 246 pages and 16 posts (articles imported from MailChimp)

The website has had 54,657 hits as of July 5, 2015, as compared to 59,648 a year ago. (We had a total of 120,168 hits in 2014.) Daily hits range between 300 and 400 (2014 average was 329). We show greater activity around expected events, such as Membership Renewals and announcements related to the national specialty.

Web:

In previous years, the number of pages that we could put into the menus was limited to 210; adding more than that broke the website. This was due to a limitation in the WordPress software. The software also limited the size of individual uploads to 10 MB, which prevented many of the old Bulletin files from being uploaded or recognized by the software. That limitation has been increased to 50 MB.

Bagpipes Report:

During FY 2015, eleven issues of the Bagpipes and Extra Edition were sent to members using Mail Chimp (October and November are combined issues because of the National Specialty.) There are currently 650 subscribers to the Mail Chimp "BCCA Paid Members - Receive all BCCA Emails" list, with an additional nine members requesting "hard copies" of the newsletter.
