TRAINING TIDBITS

Training Tidbit 1. Don't just run out and try a new skill just because you read it in a book, went to a seminar or watched a video. Without the correct building blocks, you will only confuse yourself and your dog. - Claudia Frank

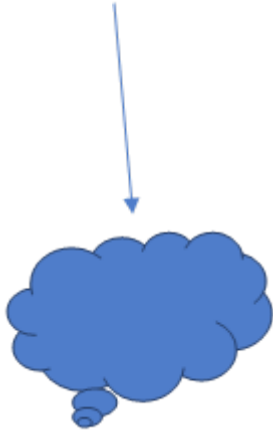
Training Tidbit 2. (Please submit a tidbit for future herding articles – photos/diagrams, too).

No doubt we are each quite certain that we know what fetch means – right? Sure – the dog will bring the stock to us along a reasonably straight line from wherever the stock are picked up. Right? Maybe yes; maybe no. Assuming a correct outrun to start the lift and fetch, the answer then depends on whether the dog can establish a line to you and adjust accordingly. You may wonder, how hard is that for the dog? It shouldn't be if they are among the majority that innately understand fetch. But you can make it difficult in more ways than one – well proven by the author. To recap,

- Phase 1. Dog leaves you and goes on that lovely outrun that leaves the stock undisturbed, steps in (lift) kindly toward stock, and then
- Phase 2. Dog looks up to see just where you are. Where are you?
 - In line with dog and stock
 - Out of line
 - In and out of line, moving in toward stock, moving away – i.e., a wandering handler, wondering why your dog isn't fetching???
 - In the figures below, you are the blue cloud
 - Yes, dog is a bit pushy – witness the flapping wings. A different topic.

Note: this approach may not work for everyone, but it did for us. I would think after years of herding, lots of herding seminars by different clinicians, many hours training with several trainers, hours walking and practicing and observing – I should have recognized the issue. But I didn't. After another trainer recently watched us work, she said – the problem is your dog doesn't know where to fetch to – be still to provide a point of reference. My task was to consciously work on keeping my feet planted in one place and wait. It was quite amazing – dog did whatever was needed (without any verbal interruptions from me) to bring ducks to me; this happened both in a good sized round pen and in an open field with a very strong draw to other ducks and home.

It helped that those ducks are trained to fetch.



You are in a straight line to dog – stand still if the ducks should be brought here.



Oops. Not straight. Stand still if this is where ducks are to come to. Dog flanks left to establish line.



You are always in motion, can't figure out where to be – dog can't figure it out either, keeps reflanking to get in line. Solution? Figure out where you want ducks brought to, plant your feet and stay there.

AKC AGILITY REPORT FOR 2018

2018 AKC STATISTICS

131 Beardies earned a total of 2,739 legs in the Regular, Preferred, FAST, T2B and Premier classes in all breed and Specialty competition. 83 competed in the Regular classes with 41 in Preferred and 7 in both. 99 of these teams accounted for 310 total titles.

One team completed three MACHs in 2018, **Lawrence Dalan and MACH 4/5/6 Bing, Wigglesworth Pride And Prejudice.**

Five teams completed two championship titles within the competition year: **Jeff Ipser with MACH 9/10 Rezoom, Wigglesworth Super Smooth Operator, Lori Weinberg with MACH 2/3 Bolt, Cameron Lightnin' Strikes Twice and MACH 9/PACH Blade, Cameron's On The Cutting Edge, Jennifer Phillips with MACH 4/5 Ryan, Estrella's Orion The Dark Hunter and Deborah Alexander with PACH/PACH2 McKenzie, Wynsum Queen Of Diamonds N' The Ruff.**

Six teams competed at the 2018 AKC Invitational held in Orlando, FL in December. Eleven teams have qualified for the AKC National Agility Championships to be held in Tulsa, OK, March 15-17, 2019. BCCA member Jeff Ipser will be on the judging panel for this prestigious event.

Finally, **Larry Dalan and Bing** had the honor of earning the first Beardie **Agility Grand Champion** title when they completed their MFG in October.

BCCA AWARDS FOR 2018

The BCCA honors the top agility teams at each competition level (Novice/Open/Excellent/Master) in both regular Standard and Jumpers With Weaves (JWW and Veteran Beardies competing in the Preferred classes. The complete scoring systems for these awards can be found on the BAD website www.BeardieAgility-Diehards.org.

CH AGCH MACH6 Wigglesworth Pride And Prejudice MXS2 PDS MJC2 PJG NAP NJP MFG TQX NFP T2B7, Bing, owned and handled by Lawrence Dalan of University City, MO, is the winner of the Diehard and Overall Jumpers

awards for the second consecutive year. They also earned the **Lightning award** which recognizes speed at the Master level in both Standard and JWW and topped the rankings in Master Standard and JWW. Larry and Bing earned 2,671 MACH points, 57 QQs, 74 Master Standard and 81 Master JWW legs in 2018 along with their MACH 4, 5, and 6 titles. They also earned 54 T2B, 47 Master FAST, 27 TQs, 32 Premier Standard and 38 Premier JWW legs. This team truly showed themselves equal to any challenge! Larry and Bing qualified for the 2018 AKC Invitational and the AKC National Agility Championship to be held in March 2019. The Diehard Award is supported by BAD. The Overall JWW award is supported by Beth White in honor of Mirage, the first winner. The Lightning award is sponsored by Lori Weinberg to honor Rocky, MACH PACH Chaniam Creag MXS MJG MXP3 MXPB MJP7 MJPS PAX XF.

The Denia award is given for competition in Standard agility to the Masters level and was initially sponsored by Emily Venator in memory of Denia, the first Beardie to earn an AKC agility title. Cheri and Marlin also won the Novice B JWW class award.

Recognition is also given to the teams earning titles at each level in Standard and JWW. The JWW awards are named in memory of Ryan, the first Beardie to earn any agility title, and were initially sponsored by Beth Canner.

2019 AKC Agility National Championship Qualifiers

The AKC National Agility Championships will be held March 15-17, 2019 at the Ford Tough Livestock Event Center in Tulsa, OK. To enter a dog must have earned at least 7 QQs (qualifying in standard and JWW on the same day 7 times) and 550 MACH/Premier points (1 MACH point = 1 full second under standard course time; each Premier Q = 15 points) between December 1, 2017 and November 30, 2018. Premier Standard/JWW legs, not necessarily earned on the same day, may be used to replace up to 3 of the requirements for 7 QQs. 11 Beardie teams have met this high standard and are eligible to enter. Our own Jeff Ipser, who qualified to compete, will be on the judging panel.

2018-2019 INVITATIONAL STANDINGS

The point accumulation year for the AKC Invitational Agility championships runs from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. We are now halfway through this period. Points are earned for each full second under standard course time (SCT) in Masters Standard and JWW; 10 points are added for each QQ. In July 2018, the top five Beardies in the rankings will be invited to compete at the Invitational which will be held in Orlando, FL in December 2017. The Beardie earning the most points in the Preferred classes will also be invited. The ranking below includes results from events through December 31, 2018.

UPDATE ON ANNIE

When I brought Annie home as a ten-week-old puppy in April of 2009, I decided what activities she would participate in as she got older, partially based on what activities could she do, as she was born deaf.

We immediately started obedience training; I learned how to communicate with her via hand signals and body language.

Thru my previous dog, Damian, I was well versed in agility but was I going to be able to train a deaf dog to do agility and where would it lead?

When she was four months old, we began agility training at Camp Gone to the Dogs in Vermont that I had attended quite a few years with Damian.

It went well except when I tried to get her attention to call her back to something. This was, and continues to be, our biggest challenge. If she's not looking at me, I've basically got nothing. Some people recommended using a vibrating collar with her and while I have one, I have never used it. My reasoning for not using it was that I wouldn't be able to use it in a competition so it wouldn't provide any help. I needed to come up with a different plan.

When she was old enough, she began her formal agility training. We did a lot of training on leash so I could get her attention when I needed to and used a lot of treats to keep her interested in staying with me as we navigated the courses.

She was quite upset when she came across her first jump with the jump bar in place as she had only been going thru the stanchions up until this time, due to her age. So, her first experience with a full jump went like this: she went up to the jump and quite proudly puffed out her chest, knocked the bar from the stanchions and proceeded to go thru them as was her normal activity. She's quite the character.

Annie started competing in CPE agility in July of 2010. It wasn't always pretty but I needed to get her exposed to different environments and try to get her to interact with me as opposed to doing countless zoomies. Over time and with lots of training sessions, she is more attune to me now. She does have one very annoying habit which is biting my feet, pants or sometimes shirt sleeve if she believes I am not where she thinks I need to be.

We have continued to train and work on our connection over the years. She will be ten in February of this year so you can see it's been a work in progress for quite a while.

We were a little bored when we would attend a Beardie specialty as we could not compete in AKC agility, due to her deafness. We could only run in the agility relay which meant that she was a wild child since it was the end of the day and she had been sitting around all day.

AKC was still debating whether deaf dogs could compete in companion events, so we were kind of stuck until ... October 1st, 2015. That's the day that AKC determined that deaf dogs could compete in agility.

This was good but could Annie and I compete in AKC since we didn't train for refusals? She still tended to wander a bit on course and bite my feet (that doesn't seem

to have gone away at all). I wasn't sure and was a bit nervous about the prospect; I didn't want anyone to think badly of Annie for doing her thing which could include zoomies or visiting the judge or ring crew.

We got our opportunity to try out AKC in a great environment in 2018 when we attended Beardie Camp. There were two AKC trials, Annie was signed up for three runs both days: Standard, Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) and Time to Beat (T2B). I didn't really know what Time to Beat was but was okay with Standard and Jumpers with Weaves. I didn't know what constituted a refusal, so that was going to be my nemesis.

Our first run of the day was JWW and to say I was nervous was an understatement, but apparently the agility gods were with us and we Q'd. That was our first Q in AKC agility. We went on to Q in Standard that day also. Time to Beat was just not going to happen for us as I was too slow.

The next day was another amazing day as we Q'd in JWW and Standard again. Ok now this was getting serious. I thought about it the whole drive home from Purina Farms back to New Jersey and decided I needed to at least finish one title in AKC since we were so close. We needed 3 Qs in Novice to get a title.

As luck would have it, a new venue had opened for AKC trials 20 minutes from home; we entered a trial in July. Once again, I was nervous because now we were playing agility with some

serious competitors. While we didn't get any Q's that weekend, I was pleased with how Annie worked as it was at a new location and it was a two- ring trial. Since she's visually distracted, it was great that she ran so well and ignored other dogs and people around the ring. She did do a bunch of air scenting which distracted her though.

Our next trial was in November. I wasn't as nervous this time as I had seen some dogs doing what Annie does, zooming around and not paying attention to their handlers. So, we went for it and I'm very proud to say that Annie got her first ever AKC agility title in Novice Standard. We didn't Q in JWW to finish out that title but we will continue to trial locally or at Beardie events so we can finish that up.

It's been an amazing journey with Annie, and I hope we have a few more years to perfect (okay almost perfect) our performance in AKC agility. We will continue to compete in CPE agility, Barn Hunt, Nosework and Rally as well as continue doing therapy work.
