TRAINING TIDBITS

With not much happening in early winter, I found some old herding seminar notes and share some bits of wisdom presented in no particular order.

It is wise to understand your dog's strength very early on. Being realistic will help you in handling and training (or finding a venue more in tune with the dog). Where is the dog on the power spectrum? Weak (not going to be very useful), average (friendly, biddable – you're in luck), strong (hard to control - needs no explanation).

Whatever task you are working on, if the dog is right, let dog continue; if dog is not right, there should normally be a correction (an exception – during early introduction to stock) or stop and reteach for the dog in learning mode. Otherwise, failure to correct “trains” the dog to think what it did was OK. In essence you just trained the dog to do something incorrect.

If a dog flanks behind handler, it likely will lose contact with the stock; this doesn't happen with an inside flank. A dog who is off contact is not in control of the stock.

Taking stock off fence line. Need peaceful tame stock that will stay in place on fence. This will take days to weeks, depending on dog and how often you train.

Begin with stock on fence (12 o'clock) and handler/dog in field/arena at 6 o'clock

Work both ways. Send dog to go around stock; they will move off fence and likely fetch to handler. Assure dog does equally well both directions

Then do with dog/handler moving to 4/8 o'clock position until successful reliably in both directions.

Continue advance of dog/handler toward fence until at the fence when you send dog along fence to do the take off.

Again, repeating both directions.

Outrun. Purpose is to reposition dog in relationship to stock. That's it. If you are starting a Beardie and the trainer lets you let the dog go beyond reposition and stop, you'll have an ongoing problem. Why? The dog quickly learns to think that what you want when you send him/her, is outrun/lift/fetch all

in one continuous sequence. It can take time to reset the mind of the average very smart Beardie – so start right and avoid the discouragement and hassle of retraining.

As noted in the first tidbit (failure to correct “trains” the dog to think what it did was OK), failure to teach a stop after repositioning, teaches the dog that continued movement is what is desired.

Rather, you want the dog to learn that when it reaches a position and stops (early in training) or hesitates (later in training) and turns in to the stock – they are allowed to get the sheep. As repetition of the sequence is practiced, you will begin to see the dog think and automatically stop/down (whatever command works best for that individual dog), then slowly get up and then move in toward the stock. In time the automatic stop/down becomes a mere hesitation, but it is there, and the stock recognize it.

During the outrun, what the dog is thinking is most important. How are you going to know what the dog is thinking? Watch the stock. They know. Sheep body language, in general, not only in the outrun:

Heads up – watching; thinking escape may be wise.

Heads down – not fearful of dog

Back leg wonky – going down, feeling stress

Running

In fear of dog – shouldering each other, banging into each other

Insufficient dog – running because they think they can get away; not banging into each other

A crossover (dog does not go in direction you ask on the outrun) means the dog's mind is in the wrong place. It is going out to chase or catch, not to reposition itself relative to the stock.

A handler's goals are to learn how to read the dog and the stock, and how to react/make decisions instantaneously. You do this with experience – pay your dues. Success is proportional to the amount of time you put into it – training the dog, working with stock, trying to compete, and thinking about it all. Be patient.

BE AWARE - HABITAT CHANGE OF THE LONE STAR TICK

“The climate crisis is making us more vulnerable to ticks in an unprecedented and growing to public health, according to a new report. Bacterial and protozoan tick-borne diseases doubled in the United States between 2004 and 2016, the report notes, and in 2017, more than 90% of the 60,000 vector-borne diseases in the United States were linked to these particular bloodsucking bugs.

The warmer temperatures brought by the climate crisis, in addition to ecological changes and reforestation, have extended the bugs' range into regions that had not seen certain types of ticks for many decades, if ever. And the report published in the New England Journal of Medicine Tuesday warns that we should be “bracing for the worst.” The lone star



tick, a tick distinguished by a white dot -- a “lone star” -- on the back of the female of the species, had been commonly found in the South. Global warming has made more regions tick-friendly. Now it also lives in the Upper Midwest, in the Northeast, and has even moved into eastern Canada.

Warmer temperatures may also extend their “active season,” researchers said, and make them much more abundant.

The good news -- if there is good news when it comes to ticks -- is that lone star ticks don't carry *Borrelia burgdorferi*, the main bacteria that causes Lyme disease. But they do carry the bacteria that causes southern tick-associated rash illness, or STARI, a rash similar to Lyme disease that also comes

with fever, fatigue, headache and muscle pains. While doctors know to watch for Lyme disease, STARI has been less common and is often misdiagnosed, the report said.

The lone star ticks also cause tularemia, known as rabbit or deer fly fever, a rare infectious disease that attacks the skin, lymph nodes and eyes; ehrlichiosis, a bacterial infection that can cause flu-like symptoms; Heartland virus disease, a virus that can also cause flu-like symptoms and often leads to hospitalization or even death; and alpha-gal syndrome, also known as red meat allergy.

And these ticks are “aggressive,” according to Richard Ostfeld, a disease ecologist with the Cary Institute of Ecosystem Studies who studies Lyme and other tick-borne diseases. Ostfeld is not affiliated with the new report. ‘Aggressive’ is a weird word to use with ticks, but they actually chase you and are very different from our wimpy black-legged ticks, the ones that have brought us Lyme disease. Those are slow, deliberate crawlers, who would have a hard time making it across my desk in half a day,” Ostfeld said. “Lone star ticks can detect you and they basically run after

OH, AND ONE MORE THING

This is written in my rehab hospital room at Roosevelt Warm Springs, GA as I work to get back to some semblance of functionality following surgery. For lotsa years my gait hasn’t been exactly smooth due to a nerve injury which resulted in a foot drop. I managed OK at farming and herding though my trainer reminded me that how I moved was sometimes a pressure on the stock, especially ducks.

Over the fall serious neurologic symptoms developed – terribly poor balance, weaker muscles, lost sensation and fine motor function in the hands and fingers. I can assure you it is very awkward to have no balance or to feel nothing when you peck away at the keyboard, or to make a jumble when tying shoelaces. At the end of September I started using a cane for balance. After my primary physician, it took seven weeks of doctor visits, consults, lab and imaging studies (and I was pushy). Surgery at Emory on 11/21 was on the cervical spine (C3-6 laminoplasty and C7 laminectomy). In the interim I also got Bill’s home care for activities of daily living started every third day and figured out how to have someone come in to feed dogs, feed Bill and visit. I was reminded that dogs are dogs when teaching the substitute feeders what to do; these are guys who work on the farm and the dogs know well yet are a bit wary of. Once the food

you. They are really upsetting. It feels like they are hunting you. “Well actually, it doesn’t just feel like that. They are hunting you.”

He said it’s good to raise awareness about the problem now -- he only wishes it went further to encourage public health leaders to be more proactive. Instead of just surveilling the disease ticks cause, as the report suggests, he hopes governments will invest in more tick research and create a surveillance program for this tick and for others. “There is so much we don’t know. We don’t know which hosts are more responsible for supporting their numbers. We don’t know which hosts are good at destroying them. We don’t know how to control them without nuking them with chemical pesticides that could also kill other things we don’t want to kill,” said Ostfeld.

“I think it is not enough to assume these diseases are going to run rampant and our only recourse is to monitor the disease,” said Ostfeld. “We need to be more aggressive to figure out how to control the tick population and how to make people more aware of the safety concerns ticks cause pets and people.”

bowls were picked up, the dogs cared not who fixed the meal and placed it on the floor. No wariness at all of the workers; no recognition that I existed.

I was moved five days later to Warm Springs. Given Thanksgiving & the weekend, I barely got started with therapy. This week it has been three hours/day, both OT and PT, to regain function by strengthening muscles, balance exercises, walking so far with a walker first, and then a cane. The progress possible is amazing though it will be many months before I find out how much nerve function will return.

Nursing staff and doctors are very good; no bar; food institutional (at least not along the line of what I eat) and I lost four pounds in the first four days. Solving that by having friends bring nuts, energy bars, and Max Ensure 30 g to supplement the offerings. I wear my Hilton Head tee shirt and joke with the staff that my time in Warm Springs is my vacation for 2019.

So, fellow herders my Christmas wish for you this holiday season is that you actively take time to appreciate the blessings of health and mobility and to enjoy your Beardies, family and others in your holiday circle of whatever faith.
