I hope you are all staying safe and well. Here in New England, the dog show/trial scene has been incredibly quiet for the past three months and from the looks of the AKC event cancellation page is likely to remain quiet for the rest of 2020. Almost all our agility, herding, rally, obedience, and conformation shows are already cancelled (sadly into December). In nearby upstate New York, there were two outdoor AKC agility trials at the end of June but it is not clear when or even if our NE trials will be allowed to go on. Remember when we used to do agility outdoors...seems to me like a dim memory from a galaxy far far away.

So now for the good news! In mid-June, AKC announced they would accept video submissions to qualify for the ACT1 title until December 31, 2020. ACT (Agility Course Test) is an entry level agility activity designed for beginner dogs and their handlers. Level 1 courses have 10 obstacles: an A-frame, a table, a tunnel, and several single jumps. You have 60 seconds to complete a course (your time will be determined from the video) and the dog must pause on the table for 5 seconds. You must have a qualifying run on two different courses to earn the ACT1 title. find directions for building the course(s) and preparing the video, an on-line entry form, and the maps for the courses. The AC-T1A/ACT1B courses are the same obstacle setup but one (A) is numbered from 1-10 and then the numbering is reversed for the second course (B) so you run it backwards. The ACT2A/ACT2B courses have the same positions for the A-frame and tunnel but different positions for some of the jumps and the table. To be eligible for ACT, your dog cannot have earned any AKC agility titles. The instruction page tells you to either submit the video directly or via a You-Tube link but they will accept links to other streaming services like Vimeo as well. You must pay via PayPal but you don't need a PayPal account as you may use PayPal's guest service.

ACT titles count towards all the BCCA versatility awards so this might be a good time to try some agility training and gain a qualification in another venue.

The AKC Agility Department announced the expansion of the virtual ACT program to include the ACT 2 class. ACT 2 is the next level of AKC agility above the entry-level ACT 1. More info at https://tinyurl.com/ycwcyvrd



A CHANGE IS IN THE AIR

Agility sure has changed. The last trial held in my area before the quarantine was March 13-15. Purina Farms shut down until the end of August, cancelling numerous agility trials, specialties, and other events. However, the weekend of June 19-21, an agility trial was held near me in Wood River, Illinois. I couldn't attend due to injury, but what follows are the precautions put in place as to how the trial was run.

Covid-19 safety measures included -

- Limit of 50 people in the building at one time.
- · Social distancing.
- Exhibitors not being allowed to stay in the building unless it was their scheduled walk through and running time.
- People were allowed to bring dogs in or out and to use the rest room. This was done with the limit of people in mind.
- Preassigned crating. Exhibitors had to fill out a crate tag with the dog's name and person's phone number with the tag to be left on the crate.
- No personal chairs could be brought into the building.
- Masks required while in the building with the exception that exhibitors could have chosen not to wear the mask while waiting at the gate or during their runs. Masks were to be put back on after the run.

2021 BCCA SPECIALTY UPDATES

Just a quick update to our members who were not able to attend our first Virtual Meet up on Zoom June 30. Here are the items we discussed:

The Wildwood Hotel reservations that were made for the September 25-October 1, 2020 National Specialty have been automatically cancelled by the hotel.

To make a new reservation for the June 2021 BCCA Specialty, you MUST make your reservation over the phone and say you are with the Bearded Collie Club of America. You will NOT get the BCCA rate if you try to book on-line.

All judges remain in the same for the June 2021 BCCA Specialty.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE SCHEDULE:

- Obedience and Rally have their own day!
- The Welcome Party is off site at Labaddie Brewery, a local craft beer brewery just five minutes from Purina. Beardies are welcome, so bring them along!
- Farm Dog Certified testing will be available, info included when the premium comes out, judges will be Maryann Szalka and Brian Wistrom.

• No printed course maps, they were posted outside and on the secretary's website.

Other interesting changes were with the running orders. This trial had 175 runs on Friday and 350 each on Saturday and Sunday.

- Friday both Premier classes, both Open classes, and both Novice classes
- Saturday both Master classes (large dogs), both Open classes, and both Novice classes
- Sunday both Master classes (small dogs), both Open classes, and both Novice classes

In August we will see a three-day trial 300 runs each day. Master and Excellent small dogs will be limited to 40 handlers per trial; Master and Excellent large dogs limited to 40 handlers per trial; and Open and Novice Standard and Jumpers with Weaves limited to 40 handlers per trial.

It will be interesting to see what requirements Purina Farms will have. In my area, we have four venue options for trialing, all less than an hour away. Three of the four are one-ring-only facilities; two have turf and other two use mats.



WHO WILL WIN THIS YEAR?

Andrew Award

Presented to the bearded collie that has performed the most service hours in therapy work during the previous year.

Avery Dudasch Award

Presented to any bearded collie that has performed pet therapy visiting ill children at a hospital during the previous year.

The Avery Award honors the memory of 11 year old Avery Dudasch, who showed great courage, hope, and faith in her battle with cancer.

Casey – The Wonder Dog Award

Recognizes any physically challenged <u>or</u> rescue Bearded Collie doing therapy work.

A "Casey" is in memory of Casey, who overcame his early life in a puppy mill and an injury that cost him a leg, to become a beloved therapy dog to thousands of people. To be eligible, dogs must have a physical challenge (e.g. missing a limb, deaf, blind) or be a rescue beardie. This certificate will be awarded to the same dog only time.
