#### Put a Little Obedience in Your Beardie's Life by Joan Blumire

There have always been dire warnings to conformation exhibitors who feel their dog has obedience potential that to indulge in this aspect of dog sport can only lead to irreperable damage for conformation. Among the most persistent arguments put forward are the tendency to sit in the conformation ring, the dog's confusion as to whether he is in obedience or conformation, faulty movement caused through heelwork, and the quelling of his animation. These opinions cannot be dismissed as mere nonsense for there are some truths to these problems—but that is what they are, mere problems for which solutions may be found, not insurmountable obstacles.

During the past few years obedience training has undergone a transition from the old style of attempting to achieve mastery of the dog to a more enlightened form of teaching through looking at things from the dog's point of view. These new techniques, using encouragement and praise rather than the application of harsh corrections when the dog is in error, have led to the production of
