The following article appeared in the December, 1982 AKC Gazette.

"Winners never quit and quitters never win," is the motto of Junior Handler Gail Miller. It certainly describes her determination and success in showing Bearded Collies and in particular, Ch. Gaymardon's Chesapeake Mist, who received BB at the BCCA National Specialty in July of 1982 and BB at Westminster 1981.

The Kennel club in England allowed Beardies, sometimes referred to as the ''humble herdsman's dog'', to be eligible for challenge certificates and championships in 1959. While living in England with her parents, before Beardies were recognized in the U.S., Gail became interested in junior handling: ''My mother began showing West Highland White Terriers and then Bearded Collies. After watching at ringside, you begin to want to go in there yourself!'' That is exactly what Gail did.

At age 11, she showed her first Bearded Collie in the U.S., Ch. Monyash Tempest Tossed for one year. She was nervous about those early experiences and advises other junior handlers, "Although you may be shaky and insecure, try to somehow let your dog know everything is O.K."

At her first National Specialty Gail showed an eightmonth-old Beardie, Gaymardon's Baron of Bramel and won Winners Dog. Her first Beardie to qualify with her for Junior Showmanship at Westminster was seven-year-old Ch. Gaymardon's Yorktown Yankee. However, they were not finalists. Although this was a disappointment to Gail, she remained optimistic, saying, "If you really want to win, you must work at it, even on small details."

The year 1982 brought six consecutive second places and according to Gail, "One starts to wonder what you are doing wrong!" She then added, "You can't please every judge, but both winning and losing inspires self-improvement and confidence." The key, she believes, is to present your dog as if he were the best.

At 15 years of age, Gail is recognized as the top BC-CA Junior Handler. She has received 12 group placements for three different Bearded Collies: Ch. Gaymardon's Bouncing Bogart, son of Ch. Gaymardon's Chesapeake Mist; Ch. Gaymardon's Yorktown Yankee and Ch. Gaymardon's Chesapeake Mist who has always been one of the top Beardies since they have been recognized. Keeping it 'all in the family', gail has

presently completed eight wins with her Beardies and has qualified for Westminster 1983.

Becoming a professional handler is a strong possibility believes Gail Miller. As a junior handler, she has gained much confidence in both herself and Bearded Collies. "Dogs are very much like children in school," she realizes, "First work, then recess, but keep in mind that handlers never take it for granted that they are going to win!"
